4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.56 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6            The code reviser shall serve as an additional member of the board  
7 of commissioners.

8            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect August 1, 2001.
