- 7 (1) The department shall attach or imprint a notation on the 8 ((driver's license)) driving record of any person restricted under RCW 46.20.720 stating that the person may operate only a motor vehicle equipped with an ignition interlock or other biological or technical
- 11 device.
- 12 (2) It is a misdemeanor for a person with such a notation on his or
- 13 her ((driver's license)) driving record to operate a motor vehicle that
- 14 is not so equipped.
