1            AN ACT Relating to exceptional faculty award grants; and amending  
2            RCW 28B.50.839 and 28B.50.837.

3            BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.50.839 and 1994 c 234 s 3 are each amended to read  
5            as follows:

6            (1) In consultation with eligible community and technical colleges,  
7            the college board shall set priorities and guidelines for the program.

8            ~~(2) ((Under this section, a college shall not receive more than  
9            four faculty grants in twenty five thousand dollar increments, with a  
10            maximum total of one hundred thousand dollars per campus in any  
11            biennium-~~

12            ~~(3))~~) All community and technical colleges and their foundations  
13            shall be eligible for matching trust funds. When they can match the  
14            state funds with equal cash donations from private sources,  
15            institutions and foundations may apply to the college board for grants  
16            from the fund in ((twenty five)) ten thousand dollar increments up to  
17            a maximum ((of one hundred thousand dollars when they can match the  
18            state funds with equal cash donations from private sources, except that  
19            in the initial year of the program, no college or foundation may

1 ~~receive more than one grant until every college or its foundation has~~  
2 ~~received one grant~~) set by the college board. These donations shall  
3 be made specifically to the exceptional faculty awards program and  
4 deposited by the institution or foundation in a local endowment fund or  
5 a foundation's fund. Otherwise unrestricted gifts may be deposited in  
6 the endowment fund by the institution or foundation.

7 ~~((4))~~ (3) Once sufficient private donations are received by the  
8 institution or foundation, the institution shall inform the college  
9 board and request state matching funds. The college board shall  
10 evaluate the request for state matching funds based on program  
11 priorities and guidelines. The college board may ask the state  
12 treasurer to release the state matching funds to a local endowment fund  
13 established by the institution or a foundation's fund established by a  
14 foundation for each faculty award created.

15 ~~((5))~~ (4) A college, by action of its board of trustees, may  
16 transfer those exceptional faculty award funds accumulated in its local  
17 endowment fund between July 1, 1991, and July 25, 1993, to its  
18 foundation's local endowment fund established as provided in subsection  
19 ~~((3))~~ (2) of this section.

20 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28B.50.837 and 2002 c 371 s 902 are each amended to  
21 read as follows:

22 (1) The Washington community and technical college exceptional  
23 faculty awards program is established. The program shall be  
24 administered by the college board. The college faculty awards trust  
25 fund hereby created shall be administered by the state treasurer.

26 (2) Funds appropriated by the legislature for the community and  
27 technical college exceptional faculty awards program shall be deposited  
28 in the college faculty awards trust fund. At the request of the  
29 college board, the treasurer shall release the state matching funds to  
30 the local endowment fund of the college or its foundation. No  
31 appropriation is necessary for the expenditure of moneys from the fund.  
32 ~~((During the 2001-2003 fiscal biennium, the legislature may appropriate~~  
33 ~~funds from the college faculty awards trust fund for the purposes of~~  
34 ~~the settlement costs of the Mader v. State litigation regarding~~  
35 ~~retirement contributions on behalf of part time faculty.))~~

1 Expenditures from the fund may be used solely for the exceptional  
2 faculty awards program.

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
