AN ACT Relating to removing suppliers and distributors of wine from the provisions of chapter 19.126 RCW; amending RCW 19.126.010 and 19.126.020; and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 19.126.010 and 1984 c 169 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (1) The legislature recognizes that both suppliers and wholesale 8 distributors of malt beverages ((and wine)) are interested in the goal 9 of best serving the public interest through the fair, efficient, and 10 competitive distribution of such beverages. The legislature encourages 11 them to achieve this goal by:

(a) Assuring the wholesale distributor's freedom to manage the
business enterprise, including the wholesale distributor's right to
independently establish its selling prices; and

(b) Assuring the supplier and the public of service from wholesale distributors who will devote their best competitive efforts and resources to sales and distribution of the supplier's products which the wholesale distributor has been granted the right to sell and distribute. 1 (2) This chapter governs the relationship between suppliers of malt 2 beverages ((and wine)) and their wholesale distributors to the full 3 extent consistent with the Constitution and laws of this state and of 4 the United States.

5 **Sec. 2.** RCW 19.126.020 and 1997 c 321 s 41 are each amended to 6 read as follows:

7 The definitions set forth in this section apply throughout this 8 chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

9 (1) "Agreement of distributorship" means any contract, agreement, 10 commercial relationship, license, association, or any other 11 arrangement, for a definite or indefinite period, between a supplier 12 and distributor.

13 (2) "Distributor" means any person, including but not limited to a component of a supplier's distribution system constituted as an 14 15 independent business, importing or causing to be imported into this 16 state, or purchasing or causing to be purchased within this state, any 17 malt beverage ((or wine)) for sale or resale to retailers licensed under the laws of this state, regardless of whether the business of 18 19 such person is conducted under the terms of any agreement with a malt 20 beverage ((or wine)) manufacturer.

(3) "Supplier" means any malt beverage ((or wine)) manufacturer or 21 importer who enters into or is a party to any agreement of 22 23 distributorship with a wholesale distributor. "Supplier" does not 24 include: (a) ((Any domestic winery licensed pursuant to RCW 66.24.170; (b) any winery or manufacturer of wine producing less than three 25 26 hundred thousand gallons of wine annually and holding a certificate of 27 approval issued pursuant to RCW 66.24.206; (c))) Any domestic brewer or microbrewer licensed under RCW 66.24.240 and producing less than fifty 28 thousand barrels of malt liquor annually; or (((d))) (b) any brewer or 29 30 manufacturer of malt liquor producing less than fifty thousand barrels 31 of malt liquor annually and holding a certificate of approval issued under RCW 66.24.270. 32

33 (4) "Malt beverage manufacturer" means every brewer, fermenter, 34 processor, bottler, or packager of malt beverages located within or 35 outside this state, or any other person, whether located within or 36 outside this state, who enters into an agreement of distributorship for

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the resale of malt beverages in this state with any wholesale
 distributor doing business in the state of Washington.

3 (5) (("Wine manufacturer" means every winery, processor, bottler, 4 or packager of wine located within or outside this state, or any other 5 person, whether located within or outside this state who enters into an 6 agreement of distributorship for the resale of wine in this state with 7 any wine wholesale distributor doing business in the state of 8 Washington.

9 (6))) "Importer" means any distributor importing beer ((or wine)) 10 into this state for sale to retailer accounts or for sale to other 11 wholesalers designated as "subjobbers" for resale.

12 ((<del>(7)</del>)) <u>(6)</u> "Person" means any natural person, corporation, 13 partnership, trust, agency, or other entity, as well as any individual 14 officers, directors, or other persons in active control of the 15 activities of such entity.

16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate 17 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 18 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 19 immediately.
