1 AN ACT Relating to the distribution of state property taxes; and
2 amending RCW 84.52.068.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 84.52.068 and 2001 c 3 s 5 are each amended to read as
5 follows:

6 (1) A portion of the proceeds of the state property tax levy shall
7 be distributed to school districts in the amounts and in the manner
8 provided in this section.

9 (2) The amount of the distribution to each school district shall be
10 based upon the average number of full-time equivalent students in the
11 school district during the previous school year, and shall be
12 calculated as follows:

13 (a) Out of taxes collected in calendar years 2001 through and
14 including 2003, an annual amount equal to one hundred forty dollars per
15 each full-time equivalent student in all school districts shall be
16 deposited in the student achievement fund to be distributed to each
17 school district based on one hundred forty dollars per full-time
18 equivalent student in the school district for each year beginning with

1 the school year 2001-2002 and through the end of the 2003-2004 school
2 year.

3 ~~((Out of taxes collected in calendar year 2004))~~ For the 2004-
4 2005 school year, an annual amount equal to ~~((four))~~ two hundred fifty-
5 four dollars per full-time equivalent student in all school districts
6 shall be deposited in the student achievement fund to be distributed to
7 each school district based on ~~((four))~~ two hundred fifty-four dollars
8 per full-time equivalent student ~~((for each year beginning with the~~
9 ~~school year 2004-2005))~~.

10 (c) For the 2005-2006 school year, an amount equal to three hundred
11 dollars per full-time equivalent student in all school districts shall
12 be deposited in the student achievement fund to be distributed to each
13 school district based on three hundred dollars per full-time equivalent
14 student.

15 (d) For the 2006-2007 school year, an amount equal to three hundred
16 seventy-five dollars per full-time equivalent student in all school
17 districts shall be deposited in the student achievement fund to be
18 distributed to each school district based on three hundred seventy-five
19 dollars per full-time equivalent student.

20 (e) For the 2007-2008 school year, an amount equal to four hundred
21 fifty dollars per full-time equivalent student in all school districts
22 shall be deposited in the student achievement fund to be distributed to
23 each school district based on four hundred fifty dollars per full-time
24 equivalent student.

25 (f) Each subsequent year following the 2007-2008 school year, the
26 amount deposited and distributed shall be adjusted for inflation as
27 defined in RCW 43.135.025((+7)) (8).

28 (3) For the 2001-2002 through 2003-2004 school years, the office of
29 the superintendent of public instruction shall verify the average
30 number of full-time equivalent students in each school district from
31 the previous school year to the state treasurer by August 1st of each
32 year.

33 (4) Beginning with the 2004-2005 school year:

34 (a) The annual distributions to each school district shall be based
35 on the average number of full-time equivalent students in the school
36 district from the previous school year as reported to the office of the
37 superintendent of public instruction by August 31st of the previous
38 school year; and

1 (b) The school district annual amounts as defined in subsection (2)
2 of this section shall be distributed on the monthly apportionment
3 schedule as defined in RCW 28A.510.250. The office of the
4 superintendent of public instruction shall notify the department of the
5 monthly amounts to be deposited into the student achievement fund to
6 meet the apportionment schedule distributions.
