- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.05 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) Each plan offered to public employees and their covered 11 12 dependents under this chapter that is not subject to the provisions of Title 48 RCW and is issued or renewed after December 31, 2006, shall 13 14 provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided that the 15 screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, 16 or physician assistant. 17
- 18 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application 19 of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as

- 1 deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the
- 2 authority of the health care authority to negotiate rates and contract

This section does not limit the authority of an insurer to negotiate rates and contract with specific 18 19 providers for the delivery of prostate cancer screening services. - NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 48.21 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) Each group disability insurance policy issued or renewed after December 31, 2006, that provides coverage for hospital or medical expenses shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant.
- 31 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application 32 of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as 33 deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the 34 authority of an insurer to negotiate rates and contract with specific 35 providers for the delivery of prostate cancer screening services. This

 - (1) Each health care service contract issued or renewed after December 31, 2006, that provides coverage for hospital or medical expenses shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant.
- 12 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as 13 deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the 14 15 authority of a contractor to negotiate rates and contract with specific 16 providers for the delivery of prostate cancer screening services. This 17 section shall not apply to medicare supplemental policies supplemental contracts covering a specified disease or other limited 18 benefits. 19
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 48.46 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) Each health maintenance agreement issued or renewed after December 31, 2006, that provides coverage for hospital or medical expenses shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant.
 - (2) All services must be provided by the health maintenance organization or rendered upon a referral by the health maintenance organization.
 - (3) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the authority of a health maintenance organization to negotiate rates and contract with specific providers for the delivery of prostate cancer

- 1 screening services. This section shall not apply to medicare
- 2 supplemental policies or supplemental contracts covering a specified
- 3 disease or other limited benefits.

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- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 48.125 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) Each self-funded multiple employer welfare arrangement established, operated, providing benefits, or maintained in this state after December 31, 2006, that provides coverage for hospital or medical expenses shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant.
- 13 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application 14 of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as 15 deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the 16 authority of a self-funded multiple employer welfare arrangement to 17 negotiate rates and contract with specific providers for the delivery 18 of prostate cancer screening services.
- 19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** A new section is added to chapter 70.47 RCW 20 to read as follows:
 - (1) Any schedule of benefits established or renewed by the Washington basic health plan after December 31, 2006, shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant.
 - (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the authority of the health care authority to negotiate rates and contract with specific providers for the delivery of prostate cancer screening services.
- 32 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 8.** A new section is added to chapter 74.09 RCW 33 to read as follows:
- 34 The department shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening

- 1 under this chapter, provided that the screening is delivered upon the
- 2 recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse
- 3 practitioner, or physician assistant.
