1            AN ACT Relating to district court judges; amending RCW 3.34.010;  
2 and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 3.34.010 and 2003 c 97 s 1 are each amended to read as  
5 follows:

6            The number of district judges to be elected in each county shall  
7 be: Adams, two; Asotin, one; Benton, three; Chelan, two; Clallam, two;  
8 Clark, six; Columbia, one; Cowlitz, two; Douglas, one; Ferry, one;  
9 Franklin, one; Garfield, one; Grant, two; Grays Harbor, two; Island,  
10 one; Jefferson, one; King, twenty-one; Kitsap, (~~three~~) four;  
11 Kittitas, two; Klickitat, two; Lewis, two; Lincoln, one; Mason, one;  
12 Okanogan, two; Pacific, two; Pend Oreille, one; Pierce, eleven; San  
13 Juan, one; Skagit, two; Skamania, one; Snohomish, eight; Spokane, ten;  
14 Stevens, one; Thurston, (~~two~~) three; Wahkiakum, one; Walla Walla,  
15 two; Whatcom, two; Whitman, one; Yakima, four. This number may be  
16 increased only as provided in RCW 3.34.020.

17            NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** For the purposes of RCW 3.34.025, the

1 district judge position for Clark county created in chapter 97, Laws of  
2 2003, is hereby recreated as of the effective date of this section.
