1 AN ACT Relating to the population thresholds for membership of the
2 county road administration board; and amending RCW 36.78.040.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 36.78.040 and 1991 c 363 s 83 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Six members of the county road administration board shall be county
7 legislative authority members and three members shall be county
8 engineers. If any member, during the term for which he or she is
9 appointed ceases to be either a member of a county legislative
10 authority or a county engineer, as the case may be, his or her
11 membership on the county road administration board is likewise
12 terminated. Three members of the board shall be from counties with a
13 population of one hundred twenty-five thousand or more. Four members
14 shall be from counties with a population of from (~~twelve~~) twenty
15 thousand to less than one hundred twenty-five thousand. Two members
16 shall be from counties with a population of less than (~~twelve~~) twenty
17 thousand. Not more than one member of the board shall be from any one

1 county.
