## (DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Requires the model policy to provide guidelines for sex offender registration, community notification, and strategies for sex offender management.

Requires the sex offender model policy work group, once convened, to first conduct a series of community meetings around the state to assess the practices and needs of communities, identify practices offender best on sex registration, community notification, and strategies for sex offender management. Once the sex offender model policy work group has received input from stakeholders on a final draft of the model policy, the policy shall be presented to the Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs for adoption or rejection.

Provides that the act shall be null and void if appropriations are not approved.
