1 On page 6, after line 26, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 6 RCW 28A.185.020 and 1990 c 33 s 168 are each amended to
3 read as follows:

4 Supplementary funds as may be provided by the state for this
5 program, in accordance with RCW 28A.150.370, shall be categorical
6 funding on an excess cost basis based upon a per student amount not to
7 exceed three percent of any district's full-time equivalent enrollment.
8 Beginning with 2007-08 school year and in each subsequent school year,
9 the legislature shall appropriate sufficient funds to provide per
10 student allocations for three percent of a district's full-time
11 equivalent enrollment. School districts shall use the increased
12 allocations to expand and offer additional advanced placement
13 opportunities for students."

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18 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after " RCW 28A.150.210;" insert
19 "amending RCW 28A.185.020;"

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EFFECT: Increases the state funding for the Highly Capable program from 2 percent of a district's K-12 enrollment to 3 percent of a district's K-12 enrollment. School districts are directed to use the new funding on expanding and offering additional Advanced Placement opportunities. The fiscal impact is estimated at \$7.1 million for the 2007-09 biennium. *It should be noted that while the statutory maximum is currently 3 percent of a district's enrollment, the Legislature is funding up to a 2 percent in the appropriations act. This amendment essentially has the effect of requiring the Legislature to fund the statutory maximum.*
