1 AN ACT Relating to unemployment and industrial insurance notices
2 required to be posted by employers; adding a new section to chapter
3 50.12 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 43.22 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 50.12 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 When an employer initially files a master application under chapter
8 19.02 RCW for the purpose, in whole or in part, of registering to pay
9 unemployment insurance taxes, the employment security department shall
10 send to the employer any printed material the department recommends or
11 requires the employer to post. Any time the printed material has
12 substantive changes in the information, the department shall send a
13 copy to each employer.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.22 RCW
15 to read as follows:

16 When an employer initially files a master application under chapter
17 19.02 RCW for the purpose, in whole or in part, of registering to pay
18 industrial insurance taxes, the department shall send to the employer

1 any printed material the department recommends or requires the employer
2 to post. Any time the printed material has substantive changes in the
3 information, the department shall send a copy to each employer.

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
