8 make the assessment report, feedback report, and corrective action
9 plan report available on the school district website. The reports
10 must be submitted to the Washington state government management

14 the superintendent of public instruction and the state board of
15 education to assist in development of a K-12 accountability and
16 performance system. The performance goal for all school districts

8 performance system. Each community and technical college that
9 receives more than five hundred thousand dollars from the
10 appropriation in this section must submit electronic copies of the

25 corrective action plan report available on its website. The reports
26 must be submitted to the Washington state government management
27 accountability and performance office to assist in improvement of
28 the state government quality and performance system. The Evergreen
29 State College must submit electronic copies of the reports to the
30 higher education coordinating board. The performance goal for the
31 Evergreen State College is sixty percent within ten years."

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33 On page 9, at the end of line 7, insert the following:

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1 "Each public entity receiving more than five hundred thousand
2 dollars from the appropriation in this section shall apply to the
3 Washington state quality award program for an independent assessment
4 of its quality management, accountability, and performance system,
5 within three years from the date of the receipt of funds, and a full
6 assessment every three years thereafter. The public entity must
7 make the assessment report, feedback report, and corrective action
8 plan report available on its website. The reports must be submitted
9 to the Washington state government management accountability and
10 performance office to assist in improvement of the state government
11 quality and performance system. The performance goal for the public
12 entity is sixty percent within ten years."

EFFECT: Requires each school district receiving more than \$5 million and each higher education institution or other public entity receiving more than \$500,000 to apply to the Washington State Quality Award Program for an independent assessment of its quality management, accountability, and performance system, within three years from the date of the receipt of funds. Each entity must make reports related to the assessment available on its website and submit the reports to the Washington State Government Management Accountability and Performance Office.

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
