1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 18.32.195 and 2005 c 454 s 1 and 2005 c 164 s 1 are
4 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

5 The commission may, without examination, issue a license to persons
6 who possess the qualifications set forth in this section.

7 (1) The commission may, upon written request of the dean of the
8 school of dentistry of the University of Washington, issue a license to
9 practice dentistry in this state to persons who have been licensed or
10 otherwise authorized to practice dentistry in another state or country
11 and who have been accepted for employment by the school of dentistry as
12 faculty members. For purposes of this subsection, this means teaching
13 members of the faculty of the school of dentistry of the University of
14 Washington. Such license shall permit the holder thereof to practice
15 dentistry within the confines of the university facilities for a period
16 of one year while he or she is so employed as a faculty member by the
17 school of dentistry of the University of Washington. It shall
18 terminate whenever the holder ceases to be a faculty member. Such
19 license shall permit the holder thereof to practice dentistry only in
20 connection with his or her duties in employment with the school of
21 dentistry of the University of Washington. This limitation shall be
22 stated on the license.

23 (2) The commission may, upon written request of the dean of the
24 school of dentistry of the University of Washington or the director of
25 a postdoctoral dental residency program (~~((under RCW 18.32.040))~~)
26 approved by the commission, issue a limited license to practice
27 dentistry in this state to university postdoctoral students or
28 residents in (~~((postgraduate))~~) dental education or (~~((postdoctorate))~~) to
29 postdoctoral residents in a dental residency program (~~((under RCW~~
30 ~~18.32.040))~~) approved by the commission. Prior to July 1, 2010, a

1 dental residency program must be accredited by the commission on dental
2 accreditation, or be in the process of obtaining such accreditation, in
3 order to be approved by the commission. On or after July 1, 2010, the
4 dental residency program must be accredited by the commission on dental
5 accreditation in order to be approved by the commission. The license
6 shall permit the resident dentist to provide dental care only in
7 connection with his or her duties as a university postdoctoral dental
8 student or resident or a ((~~postdoctorate~~)) postdoctoral resident in a
9 program ((~~under RCW 18.32.040~~)) approved by the commission.

10 (3) The commission may condition the granting of a license under
11 this section with terms the commission deems appropriate. All persons
12 licensed under this section shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the
13 commission to the same extent as other members of the dental
14 profession, in accordance with this chapter, and in addition the
15 licensee may be disciplined by the commission after a hearing has been
16 held in accordance with the provisions set forth in this chapter, and
17 determination by the commission that such licensee has violated any of
18 the restrictions set forth in this section.

19 (4) Persons applying for licensure pursuant to this section shall
20 pay the application fee determined by the secretary and, in the event
21 the license applied for is issued, a license fee at the rate provided
22 for licenses generally. After review by the commission, licenses
23 issued under this section may be renewed annually if the licensee
24 continues to be employed as a faculty member of the school of dentistry
25 of the University of Washington, or is a university postdoctoral
26 student or resident in ((~~postgraduate~~)) dental education, or a
27 ((~~postdoctorate~~)) postdoctoral resident in a dental residency program
28 ((~~under RCW 18.32.040~~)) approved by the commission, and otherwise meets
29 the requirements of the provisions and conditions deemed appropriate by
30 the commission. Any person who obtains a license pursuant to this
31 section may, without an additional application fee, apply for licensure
32 under this chapter, in which case the applicant shall be subject to
33 examination and the other requirements of this chapter.

34 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate
35 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
36 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
37 immediately."
