

SSB 6738 - S AMD 121

1       Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3       "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) The department of fish and wildlife  
4 must work with appropriate stakeholders including, at minimum, regional  
5 fisheries enhancement groups, food banks, current and past surplus  
6 salmon disposal contractors, commercial and recreational fishers,  
7 tribes, and commercial aquaculture in order to facilitate the  
8 disposition of surplus salmon, including eggs and carcasses, in the  
9 manner that best utilizes the resource and enhances both: Revenues to  
10 regional fisheries enhancement groups authorized under RCW 77.95.060;  
11 and the provision of nutrients to food banks. The department of fish  
12 and wildlife must provide a summary of these discussions, outcomes, and  
13 any recommendations, including legislative recommendations, to the  
14 appropriate committees of the legislature by November 1, 2010.

15       (2) After November 1, 2010, the department of fish and wildlife may  
16 not solicit or award a contract providing for the purchase and  
17 processing of surplus salmon unless the department has: Completed the  
18 requirements of subsection (1) of this section; and given due  
19 consideration to integrating any recommendations developed under  
20 subsection (1) of this section into the contract planning,  
21 solicitation, and award process.

22       (3) The department of fish and wildlife must carry out the  
23 requirements of this section within existing funds.

24       (4) This section expires December 31, 2011."

1        On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "hatcheries;" strike the  
2 remainder of the title and insert "creating a new section; and  
3 providing an expiration date."

EFFECT:       Prohibits the department of fish and wildlife from soliciting or awarding a surplus salmon disposal contract after the conclusion of the stakeholder process without first giving due consideration to implementing recommendations developed during that process. Delays the expiration date of the bill by one year to December 31, 2011.
