1 AN ACT Relating to the judicial conduct commission; and amending
2 RCW 2.64.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.64.020 and 2005 c 15 s 1 are each amended to read as
5 follows:

6 (1) The commission shall consist of ~~((eleven))~~ fourteen members.
7 ~~((One))~~ Two members shall be ~~((a))~~ judges selected by and from the
8 court of appeals judges; ~~((one))~~ two members shall be ~~((a))~~ judges
9 selected by and from the superior court judges; ~~((one))~~ two members
10 shall be ~~((a))~~ judges selected by and from the limited jurisdiction
11 court judges; two members shall be selected by the state bar
12 association and be admitted to the practice of law in this state; and
13 six members shall be nonlawyers appointed by the governor. The term of
14 each member of the commission shall be four years.

15 (2) No commission member or alternate who participates in an
16 investigation or initial proceeding leading to a finding of probable
17 cause may participate in any further proceedings on that cause,

1 including a public hearing.
