

SSB 6455 - S AMD 46

1 On page 2, after line 35, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 3. RCW 46.20.293 and 2007 c 424 s 1 are each amended to read
3 as follows:

4 The department is authorized to provide juvenile courts with the
5 department's record of traffic charges compiled under RCW 46.52.101 and
6 13.50.200, against any minor upon the request of any state juvenile
7 court or duly authorized officer of any juvenile court of this state.
8 Further, the department is authorized to provide any juvenile court
9 with any requested service which the department can reasonably perform
10 which is not inconsistent with its legal authority which substantially
11 aids juvenile courts in handling traffic cases and which promotes
12 highway safety.

13 The department is authorized to furnish to the parent, parents, or
14 guardian of any person under eighteen years of age who is not
15 emancipated from such parent, parents, or guardian, the department
16 records of traffic charges compiled against the person and shall
17 collect for the copy a fee of (~~ten~~) fifteen dollars, fifty percent of
18 which must be deposited in the highway safety fund and fifty percent of
19 which must be deposited according to RCW 46.68.038.

20 **Sec. 4.** RCW 46.29.050 and 2010 c 8 s 9028 are each amended to read
21 as follows:

22 (1) The department shall upon request furnish any person or his or
23 her attorney a certified abstract of his or her driving record, which
24 abstract shall include enumeration of any motor vehicle accidents in
25 which such person has been involved. Such abstract shall (a) indicate
26 the total number of vehicles involved, whether the vehicles were
27 legally parked or moving, and whether the vehicles were occupied at the
28 time of the accident; and (b) contain reference to any convictions of
29 the person for violation of the motor vehicle laws as reported to the

1 department, reference to any findings that the person has committed a
2 traffic infraction which have been reported to the department, and a
3 record of any vehicles registered in the name of the person. The
4 department shall collect for each abstract the sum of (~~ten~~) fifteen
5 dollars, fifty percent of which shall be deposited in the highway
6 safety fund and fifty percent of which must be deposited according to
7 RCW 46.68.038.

8 (2) The department shall upon request furnish any person who may
9 have been injured in person or property by any motor vehicle, with an
10 abstract of all information of record in the department pertaining to
11 the evidence of the ability of any driver or owner of any motor vehicle
12 to respond in damages. The department shall collect for each abstract
13 the sum of (~~ten~~) fifteen dollars, fifty percent of which shall be
14 deposited in the highway safety fund and fifty percent of which must be
15 deposited according to RCW 46.68.038."

16 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
17 internal references accordingly.
