- 1 AN ACT Relating to prohibiting the use of state funds and tuition
- 2 fees for intercollegiate athletic expenses at the University of
- 3 Washington and Washington State University; amending RCW 28B.10.703;
- 4 and reenacting and amending RCW 28B.15.031.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 Sec. 1. RCW 28B.10.703 and 1977 ex.s. c 169 s 32 are each amended to read as follows:
- 8 The governing boards of each of the state universities, the
- 9 regional universities, The Evergreen State College, and community
- 10 colleges in addition to their other duties prescribed by law shall have
- 11 the power and authority to establish programs for intercollegiate
- 12 athletic competition; however, such programs at the University of
- 13 <u>Washington and Washington State University shall not be funded with</u>
- 14 state appropriations or operating fees as defined in RCW 28B.15.031.
- 15 Such competition may include participation as a member of an athletic
- 16 conference or conferences, in accordance with conference rules.
- 17 Sec. 2. RCW 28B.15.031 and 2011 1st sp.s. c 10 s 2 and 2011 c 274
- 18 s 2 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

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(1) The term "operating fees" as used in this chapter shall include 1 the fees, other than building fees, charged all students registering at 2 the state's colleges and universities but shall not include fees for 3 4 short courses, self-supporting degree credit programs and courses, marine station work, experimental station work, correspondence or 5 extension courses, and individual instruction and student deposits or 6 7 disciplinary and library fines, which colleges 8 universities shall have the right to impose, laboratory, gymnasium, 9 health, technology and student activity fees, or fees, charges, rentals, and other income derived from any or all revenue producing 10 lands, buildings and facilities of the colleges or universities 11 heretofore or hereafter acquired, constructed or installed, including 12 13 but not limited to income from rooms, dormitories, dining rooms, 14 hospitals, infirmaries, housing or student activity buildings, 15 vehicular parking facilities, land, or the appurtenances thereon, or such other special fees as may be established by any college or 16 17 university board of trustees or regents from time to time. All moneys 18 received as operating fees at any institution of higher education shall 19 be deposited in a local account containing only operating fees revenue and related interest: PROVIDED, That: (a) A minimum of five percent 20 21 of operating fees shall be retained by the four-year institutions of 22 higher education that increase tuition for resident undergraduate 23 students above assumed tuition increases in the omnibus appropriations 24 act((-)); (b) a minimum of four percent of operating fees shall be retained by four-year institutions of higher education that do not 25 26 increase tuition for resident undergraduates above assumed increases in the omnibus appropriations $act((\frac{1}{2}, \frac{1}{2}))$; (c) a minimum of three and 27 28 one-half percent of operating fees shall be retained by the community 29 and technical colleges for the purposes of RCW 28B.15.820; and (d) 30 operating fees of the University of Washington and Washington State University shall not be used to fund programs established for 31 intercollegiate athletic competition authorized under RCW 28B.10.703, 32 except that this prohibition on the use of operating fees is not 33 applicable to tuition waivers provided to achieve gender equity in 34 35 intercollegiate athletic competition in accordance with RCW 28B.15.740. 36 At least thirty percent of operating fees required to be retained by 37 the four-year institutions for purposes of RCW 28B.15.820 shall be used only for the purposes of RCW 28B.15.820(10). 38

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(2) In addition to the three and one-half percent of operating fees retained by the institutions under subsection (1) of this section, up to three percent of operating fees charged to students at community and technical colleges shall be transferred to the community and technical college innovation account for the implementation of the college board's strategic technology plan in RCW 28B.50.515. The percentage to be transferred to the community and technical college innovation account shall be determined by the college board each year but shall not exceed three percent of the operating fees collected each year.

(3) Local operating fee accounts shall not be subject to appropriation by the legislature or allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW.

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
