equally to state registered domestic partnerships or individuals in 1 2 state registered domestic partnerships as well as to marital relationships and married persons, and references to dissolution of 3 marriage shall apply equally to state registered domestic partnerships 4 that have been terminated, dissolved, or invalidated, unless the 5 <u>legislation expressly states otherwise and</u> to the extent that such 6 interpretation does not conflict with federal law. Where necessary to 7 implement chapter 521, Laws of 2009, gender-specific terms such as 8 husband and wife used in any statute, rule, or other law shall be 9 construed to be gender neutral, and applicable to individuals in state 10 registered domestic partnerships. 11
