1 AN ACT Relating to the proper disposal of legal amounts of
2 marijuana inadvertently left at retail stores holding a pharmacy
3 license; and adding a new section to chapter 69.50 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 69.50 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 Upon finding one ounce or less of marijuana inadvertently left at
8 a retail store holding a pharmacy license, the store manager or
9 employee must promptly notify the local law enforcement agency or the
10 Washington state patrol. After notification to the local law
11 enforcement agency or the Washington state patrol, the store manager or
12 employee must properly dispose of the marijuana.
