4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.35.202 and 2012 c 229 s 810 are each amended to
6 read as follows:

7 The boards of trustees of Central Washington University, Eastern
8 Washington University, and Western Washington University may offer
9 educational specialist degrees.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.40 RCW
11 to read as follows:

12 The board of trustees of The Evergreen State College may offer
13 educational specialist degrees.
