House Bills

HB 1070 by Representatives Hurst and Dahlquist
 Addressing employer notification upon commercial driver's license suspension.
 Requires the department of licensing to: (1) Notify a driver's employer, if the employer is on file with the department, upon a determination regarding the suspension, revocation, or cancellation of a commercial driver's license or disqualification of the driver from operating a commercial motor vehicle; and
 (2) Establish a voluntary database in which an employer may register an employee for which the employer wishes to receive the notification mentioned above.

HB 1071 by Representatives Blake and Chandler
 Regarding state and private partnerships for managing salmonid hatcheries.
 Expands the long-range business plan, with regard to state and private partnerships for managing salmonid hatcheries, to include the harvesting of hatchery chum salmon.

HB 1072 by Representatives Chandler, Sells, Ormsby, Reykdal, Freeman, Fagan, and Morrell
 Creating the agricultural labor skills and safety grant program.
 Requires the department of commerce, subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this specific purpose, to create and administer the agricultural labor skills and safety grant program to provide training opportunities for agricultural workers.

Expires July 1, 2016.

HB 1073 by Representatives Johnson, Blake, Chandler, Haigh, Takko, Ross, and Schmick
 Concerning payments to counties in lieu of property taxes on state-owned land.
 Requires the state treasurer, on behalf of the department of fish and wildlife, to pay an amount on game lands, in lieu of real property taxes.

HB 1074 by Representatives Angel, Takko, Buys, and Pike
 Concerning requirements governing and associated with plat approvals.
 Changes certain time limitations governing and associated with plat approvals.

HB 1075 by Representatives Lytton, Blake, Chandler, Haigh, and Morris
 Concerning the number of Puget Sound Dungeness crab fishery licenses that one vessel may be designated to carry.
 Increases the number of Puget Sound Dungeness crab fishery licenses that one vessel may be designated to carry.

HB 1076 by Representatives Haigh, Johnson, Takko,

Expanding participation in innovation academy cooperatives.

Allows high school students residing in other school districts to enroll in the innovation academy cooperative.

HB 1077 by Representatives Haigh, Lytton, Takko, and Johnson

Authorizing the educational service district board to fill vacancies on the board of directors in second-class school districts with an at-large appointment if after one hundred twenty days a candidate from the director district cannot be recruited.

Authorizes an educational service district board, when filling a position in a second-class school district that has been vacant for more than ninety days, to appoint, under certain conditions, a qualified candidate who is a resident of the school district but does not reside in the director district where there is a vacancy.

Senate Bills

SB 5025 by Senators Roach and Conway; by request of Governor Gregoire

Providing that a proclamation of a state of emergency is effective upon the governor's signature.

Requiring prepaid postage for primary and general election ballots.

Requires return envelopes for primary and general election ballots to include prepaid postage.

Requires the state to reimburse counties for the cost of return postage on mail and absentee ballots for primary and general elections.

Creating the Washington investment trust.

Creates the Washington investment trust as a legacy institution that amasses sufficient capital reserves to address opportunities now and in the future.

Creates the Washington investment trust commission as the primary governing authority of the trust.

Creates the trust transition board and the investment trust advisory board. The trust transition board expires July 1, 2014.

Exempts the trust from payment of all fees and taxes levied by the state or any of its subdivisions.

Extending the Chinook scenic byway.

Sets the western terminus of the Chinook scenic byway within Enumclaw's city limits and makes attractions within the city eligible for future grant opportunities by establishing an all-encompassing entrance point for the Chinook scenic byway.

SB 5031 by Senator Padden

Requiring actions for damage to real property resulting from construction, alteration, or repair on adjacent property to be commenced within two years after the property owner first discovered or reasonably should have discovered the damage.

 Concerning the labeling of seafood.
 Revises seafood labeling requirements.
 Addresses penalties for unlawful misbranding of food fish or shellfish.

- SB 5038** by Senators McAuliffe, Chase, Shin, Keiser, Rolfes, Nelson, Kohl-Welles, Kline, and Hobbs; by request of Governor Gregoire
 Enhancing the basic education allocation formula for principals, assistant principals, and other certificated building-level administrators to support the teacher evaluation program requirements of RCW 28A.405.100.
 Adjusts principal staffing ratios in the prototypical school models to assure implementation of the new teacher evaluation system.

 Increasing revenues dedicated to basic education purposes.
 Extends the time for additional taxes on certain business and service activities.
 Requires the revenues collected from the additional tax to be deposited into the education legacy trust account.
 Imposes a new excise tax on taxable fuel to provide funding for state allocations to school districts for pupil transportation purposes.

 Incorporating state tax expenditures into the state budget process.
 Requires the omnibus operating appropriations bill enacted by the legislature to include a section on the following: (1) All discretionary state tax expenditures together with an estimate of the state revenue impact associated with each expenditure;
 (2) The total estimated revenue impact from all discretionary state tax expenditures, total appropriations, and total state expenditures representing the sum of discretionary state tax expenditures and appropriations; and
 (3) The total state revenue impact from all nondiscretionary tax expenditures.
 Changes the duties of the department of revenue with regard to preparation and submission of a listing of the amount of reduction in the revenues of the state, or the revenues of local government collected by the state, as a result of tax expenditures.
 Requires the governor to prepare a tax expenditure report as part of the biennial budget documents.

Requires the office of the superintendent of public instruction to enter into any necessary data-sharing agreements with the office of student financial assistance to facilitate implementation of the program.
Creates the GET ready for college account.

Allowing day spas to offer or supply without charge wine or beer by the individual glass to a customer for consumption on the premises.

Creates a day spa permit that allows the permit holder to offer or supply wine or beer to customers for consumption on the premises.
