- AN ACT Relating to water rights appurtenant to land managed by 1
- 2 the department of fish and wildlife; and adding new sections to

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 4
- 5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.12 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The department must maintain and annually update an inventory of water rights appurtenant to each parcel of land owned or managed
- 9 by the department. The inventory must include information regarding
- whether the department is using, has used within the most recent 10
- 11 four-year period, or plans to use within the subsequent four-year
- period all, or a portion of, each water right for out-of-stream 12
- beneficial uses. 13
- 14 (2) Unless the department's nonuse of a water right meets the
- sufficient cause exception listed in RCW 90.14.140(1), the department 15
- 16 must offer for leasing, at comparable market terms, for out-of-stream
- 17 beneficial uses all water rights indicated in the inventory created
- under this section: 18
- 19 (a) That are not the subject of current, out-of-stream beneficial
- 20 uses;

- 1 (b) That have not been the subject of out-of-stream beneficial 2 uses in the previous four years; or
- 3 (c) That are not the planned subject of out-of-stream beneficial 4 uses in the succeeding four years.
 - (3) All proceeds from water right leases entered into by the department under this section must be deposited into the habitat enhancement and leasing account created in section 2 of this act.
- 8 (4) All water right leases entered into by the department under 9 this section must be consistent with chapter 90.03 or 90.44 RCW, as 10 appropriate.
 - (5) This section does not apply to:

- 12 (a) Properties with deed restrictions in conflict with this 13 section or where application of this section would otherwise violate 14 law; and
- 15 (b) Nonconsumptive water rights used by fish hatcheries and 16 associated rearing ponds.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 77.12 18 RCW to read as follows:
- 19 (1) The habitat enhancement and leasing account is created in the 20 state treasury. All receipts from the leasing of water rights under 21 section 1 of this act must be deposited in the account.
- 22 (2) Moneys in the account may be spent only after 23 appropriation. Expenditures from the account may only be used by the 24 department to:
- 25 (a) Provide funding to regional fisheries enhancement groups 26 incorporated under chapter 77.95 RCW;
- 27 (b) Maintain or increase production at department-managed fish 28 hatcheries;
- 29 (c) Acquire or enhance habitat for endangered, protected, or 30 threatened terrestrial species, such as the pygmy rabbit; and
- 31 (d) Control weeds and other invasive plants on department-managed lands.
