- 1 AN ACT Relating to infectious disease testing for good
- 2 samaritans; and amending RCW 70.05.180.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.05.180 and 1999 c 391 s 2 are each amended to read as follows:
- A person rendering emergency care or transportation, commonly known as a "Good Samaritan," as described in RCW 4.24.300 and
- 8 4.24.310, may request and receive appropriate infectious disease
- 9 testing free of charge from the local health department of the county
- 10 of her or his residence, if((\div (1))) while rendering emergency care
- 11 she or he came into contact with bodily fluids((\div and (2) she or he
- 12 does not have health insurance that covers the testing)). Testing of
- 13 the source patient may be performed in order to guide postexposure
- 14 prophylaxis treatment of the good samaritan. If the exchange of
- 15 <u>bodily fluids significantly increases the odds of the good samaritan</u>
- 16 being exposed to a deadly infectious disease, testing of the source
- 17 patient may be performed without the consent of the source patient.
- 18 Source patient testing may be requested and received free of charge
- 19 from the local health department of the county of his or her
- 20 <u>residence.</u> Nothing in this section requires a local health department

to provide health care services beyond testing. The department shall adopt rules implementing this section.

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The information obtained from infectious disease testing is subject to statutory confidentiality provisions, including those of chapters 70.24 and 70.05 RCW.
