1 AN ACT Relating to using computer sciences to satisfy world
2 language college admission requirements; creating a new section; and
3 providing an expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) Within existing resources, the student
6 achievement council, the office of the superintendent of public
7 instruction, and an organization that represents the public four-year
8 institutions of higher education shall facilitate a dialogue with
9 state universities, the regional universities, each as defined in RCW
10 28B.10.016, and The Evergreen State College and report to the
11 legislature by November 1, 2017, on the curriculum, courses, and
12 course sequencing necessary in the K-12 secondary schools to allow
13 two years of computer sciences to count as two years of world
14 languages for the purposes of admission into a four-year institution
15 of higher education as defined in RCW 28B.10.016.
