- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.608 and 2013 c 139 s 1 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
 - (1) All motorcycles are entitled to full use of a lane and no motor vehicle shall be driven in such a manner as to deprive any motorcycle of the full use of a lane. This subsection shall not apply to motorcycles operated two abreast in a single lane.
 - (2) The operator of a motorcycle ((shall not)) may overtake and pass in the same lane occupied by the vehicle being overtaken. ((However, this subsection shall not apply when the operator of a motorcycle overtakes and passes a pedestrian or bicyclist while maintaining a safe passing distance of at least three feet.))
 - (3) No person shall operate a motorcycle between lanes of traffic or between adjacent lines or rows of vehicles <u>unless the operator of a motorcycle is traveling at a rate of speed no more than ten miles per hour over the speed of traffic flow and not more than thirty-five miles per hour. Any operator of a motor vehicle that intentionally impedes or attempts to prevent any operator of a motorcycle from</u>

- operating his or her motorcycle as permitted under this subsection is quilty of a traffic infraction.
- 3 (4) Motorcycles shall not be operated more than two abreast in a 4 single lane.
- 5 (5) Subsection((s-(2)-and)) (3) of this section shall not apply to police officers in the performance of their official duties.
