1 AN ACT Relating to exempting the addresses of certain child care  
2 providers from the public records act; and amending RCW 42.56.230.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.56.230 and 2014 c 142 s 1 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 The following personal information is exempt from public  
7 inspection and copying under this chapter:

8 (1) Personal information in any files maintained for students in  
9 public schools, patients or clients of public institutions or public  
10 health agencies, or welfare recipients;

11 (2)(a) Personal information:

12 (i) For a child enrolled in licensed child care in any files  
13 maintained by the department of early learning, including the street  
14 address of child care facilities and the home address of a child care  
15 provider exempt from licensing under chapter 43.215 RCW; or

16 (ii) For a child enrolled in a public or nonprofit program  
17 serving or pertaining to children, adolescents, or students,  
18 including but not limited to early learning or child care services,  
19 parks and recreation programs, youth development programs, and after-  
20 school programs.

1 (b) Emergency contact information under this subsection (2) may  
2 be provided to appropriate authorities and medical personnel for the  
3 purpose of treating the individual during an emergency situation;

4 (3) Personal information in files maintained for employees,  
5 appointees, or elected officials of any public agency to the extent  
6 that disclosure would violate their right to privacy;

7 (4) Information required of any taxpayer in connection with the  
8 assessment or collection of any tax if the disclosure of the  
9 information to other persons would: (a) Be prohibited to such persons  
10 by RCW 84.08.210, 82.32.330, 84.40.020, 84.40.340, or any ordinance  
11 authorized under RCW 35.102.145; or (b) violate the taxpayer's right  
12 to privacy or result in unfair competitive disadvantage to the  
13 taxpayer;

14 (5) Credit card numbers, debit card numbers, electronic check  
15 numbers, card expiration dates, or bank or other financial account  
16 numbers, except when disclosure is expressly required by or governed  
17 by other law;

18 (6) Personal and financial information related to a small loan or  
19 any system of authorizing a small loan in RCW 31.45.093;

20 (7)(a) Any record used to prove identity, age, residential  
21 address, social security number, or other personal information  
22 required to apply for a driver's license or identicard.

23 (b) Information provided under RCW 46.20.111 that indicates that  
24 an applicant declined to register with the selective service system.

25 (c) Any record pertaining to a vehicle license plate, driver's  
26 license, or identicard issued under RCW 46.08.066 that, alone or in  
27 combination with any other records, may reveal the identity of an  
28 individual, or reveal that an individual is or was, performing an  
29 undercover or covert law enforcement, confidential public health  
30 work, public assistance fraud, or child support investigative  
31 activity. This exemption does not prevent the release of the total  
32 number of vehicle license plates, drivers' licenses, or identicards  
33 that, under RCW 46.08.066, an agency or department has applied for,  
34 been issued, denied, returned, destroyed, lost, and reported for  
35 misuse.

36 (d) Any record pertaining to a vessel registration issued under  
37 RCW 88.02.330 that, alone or in combination with any other records,  
38 may reveal the identity of an individual, or reveal that an  
39 individual is or was, performing an undercover or covert law  
40 enforcement activity. This exemption does not prevent the release of

1 the total number of vessel registrations that, under RCW 88.02.330,  
2 an agency or department has applied for, been issued, denied,  
3 returned, destroyed, lost, and reported for misuse; and

4 (8) All information related to individual claims resolution  
5 structured settlement agreements submitted to the board of industrial  
6 insurance appeals under RCW 51.04.063, other than final orders from  
7 the board of industrial insurance appeals.

8 Upon request by the legislature, the department of licensing  
9 shall provide a report to the legislature containing all of the  
10 information in subsection (7)(c) and (d) of this section that is  
11 subject to public disclosure.

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
