- 1 AN ACT Relating to clarifying the limited authority of park 2 rangers; and amending RCW 79A.05.160.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 79A.05.160 and 2011 c 320 s 15 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The members of the commission and its designated employees 7 shall be vested with police powers to enforce the laws of this state:
- 8 (a) Within the boundaries of any state park, including lands
 9 owned or managed by the commission under lease or other agreement;
- 10 <u>(b) In winter recreation facilities established and administered</u>
 11 by the commission pursuant to RCW 79A.05.225(1)(a);
- (c) On public properties immediately surrounding the state park
 up to one mile from the boundary, for violations impacting park
- 14 visitor safety or resource protection;
- 15 <u>(d) Throughout the state, in response to an emergency involving</u> 16 an immediate threat to human life or property;
- 17 <u>(e) In response to the request of a peace officer with</u>
 18 enforcement authority;
- 19 <u>(f) When in fresh pursuit, as the term "fresh pursuit" is defined</u> 20 in RCW 10.93.120; or
