- 1 AN ACT Relating to radiology benefit managers; and adding a new
- 2 chapter to Title 19 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) Any radiology benefit manager that is owned by a carrier as defined in RCW 48.43.005 or acts as a
- 6 subcontractor for a carrier must be registered with the department of
- 7 revenue's business licensing service and annually renew the
- 8 registration.
- 9 (2)(a) For purposes of this section, a "radiology benefit 10 manager" means a person that contracts with, or is owned by, a
- 11 carrier or a third-party payor to:
- 12 (i) Process claims for services and procedures performed by a
- 13 licensed radiologist or advanced diagnostic imaging service provider;
- 14 or
- 15 (ii) Pay or authorize payment to radiology clinics, radiologists,
- 16 or advanced diagnostic imaging service providers for services or
- 17 procedures;
- 18 (b) "Radiology benefit manager" does not include a health care
- 19 service contractor as defined in RCW 48.44.010, a health maintenance
- 20 organization as defined in RCW 48.46.020, or an issuer as defined in
- 21 RCW 48.01.053.

- 1 (3) To register under this section, a radiology benefit manager 2 must:
- 3 (a) Submit an application requiring the following information:
 - (i) The identity of the radiology benefit manager;

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- 5 (ii) The name, business address, phone number, and medical director for the radiology benefit manager; and
- 7 (iii) Where applicable, the federal tax employer identification 8 number for the entity; and
 - (b) Pay a registration fee of two hundred dollars.
- 10 (4) To renew a registration under this section, a radiology 11 benefit manager must pay a renewal fee of two hundred dollars.
- 12 (5) All receipts from registrations and renewals collected by the 13 department of revenue must be deposited into the business license 14 account created in RCW 19.02.210.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Section 1 of this act constitutes a new 16 chapter in Title 19 RCW.

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
