- 1 AN ACT Relating to prevocational services for individuals with
- 2 developmental disabilities; adding a new section to chapter 71A.12
- 3 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that individuals
- 6 with developmental disabilities should be allowed to participate in
- 7 prevocational services if they choose. Requiring individuals to
- 8 transition out of this environment against their wishes undermines
- 9 the guiding supreme court decision in Olmstead v. L.C., 527 U.S. 581,
- 10 which held that Title II of the Americans with disabilities act of
- 11 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12131 et. seq.) requires states to provide certain
- 12 individuals with developmental disabilities community-based program
- 13 options rather than institutional placements, but that there is no
- 14 requirement that community-based treatments be imposed on individuals
- 15 against their will.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 71A.12
- 17 RCW to read as follows:

- 1 The department shall develop rules to allow clients to
- 2 participate in prevocational services, if available and requested by
- 3 the client.
