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- AN ACT Relating to the reporting of highway construction project
- 2 errors; and adding a new section to chapter 47.01 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.01 5 RCW to read as follows:
- The department must submit a report to the legislature detailing engineering errors on highway construction projects resulting in project cost increases in excess of five hundred thousand dollars.
- 8 project cost increases in excess of five hundred thousand dollars. 9 The department must submit an initial report of an engineering error
- 10 within thirty days of when the error occurred or when the department
- 11 became aware of the error. A full report must be submitted within
- 12 ninety days of the engineering error. The department may forego
- 13 submitting an initial report and submit the final report after ninety
- 14 days if the department and a contractor are contesting liability for
- 15 the engineering error.
- 16 (1) The department's report must include an assessment and review 17 of:
- 18 (a) How the engineering error happened;
- 19 (b) Who was responsible for the engineering error;
- 20 (c) What disciplinary action was taken;
- 21 (d) The amount of risk reserve on the project; and

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- 1 (e) The amount of risk reserve used to address the engineering 2 error.
- (2) If the error resulted in a project cost increase in excess of 3 one million dollars, the report must also assess:

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- (a) Why the responsible department employee or employees were not 5 6 terminated; and
- (b) What action the secretary recommends to avoid similar errors 7 in the future. 8
- (3) If the legislature finds that the actions taken by the 9 secretary were inadequate, the legislature may take additional action 10 11 to correct the problem.

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
