- 3 to chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and
- 4 creating a new section.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.08 7 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 does not apply to sales of
- 9 technology to public schools, as defined in RCW 28A.150.010,
- 10 including, but not limited to: Computers, printers, projectors,
- 11 document cameras, smart boards, classroom technology, software,
- 12 service systems, databases, internet, network security,
- 13 subscriptions, online applications, and software licenses.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.12
- 15 RCW to read as follows:
- 16 The provisions of this chapter do not apply with respect to the
- 17 use of technology in public schools, as defined in RCW 28A.150.010,
- 18 including, but not limited to: Computers, printers, projectors,
- 19 document cameras, smart boards, classroom technology, software,

- 1 service systems, databases, internet, network security,
- 2 subscriptions, online applications, and software licenses.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The legislature intends for the tax
- 4 preferences created in this act to be permanent. Therefore, the tax
- 5 preferences created in sections 1 and 2 of this act are exempt from
- 6 the ten-year expiration provision in RCW 82.32.805(1)(a).
