- 9 abuse, and potentially prevent a child from further traumatization or
- 10 injury.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 7.68 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this
- 14 specific purpose, the department must pay, secondary to other
- 15 insurance benefits, all costs incurred by an institution as defined
- 16 by RCW 26.44.020 for the examination of a suspected victim of assault
- 17 of a child when the examination is conducted within seventy-five days
- 18 of the filing of a petition for dependency under chapter 13.34 or
- 19 26.44 RCW.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act expires June 30, 2019.
