1       AN ACT Relating to athlete agents; amending RCW 19.225.010,  
2 19.225.020, 19.225.030, 19.225.040, 19.225.050, 19.225.060,  
3 19.225.070, 19.225.080, 19.225.090, 19.225.100, and 19.225.120; and  
4 adding a new section to chapter 19.225 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6       **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.225.010 and 2002 c 131 s 2 are each amended to  
7 read as follows:

8       In this chapter:

9       (1) "Agency contract" means an agreement in which a  
10 student((-))athlete authorizes a person to negotiate or solicit on  
11 behalf of the ((~~student-~~))athlete a professional-sports-services  
12 contract or an endorsement contract.

13       (2)(a) "Athlete agent" means an individual who ((~~enters into an~~  
14 ~~agency contract with a student-athlete or,~~)):

15       (i) Directly or indirectly, recruits or solicits a  
16 student((-))athlete to enter into an agency contract or, for  
17 compensation, procures employment or offers, promises, attempts, or  
18 negotiates to obtain employment for a student athlete as a  
19 professional athlete or member of a professional sports team or  
20 organization;

1 (ii) For compensation or in anticipation of compensation related  
2 to a student athlete's participation in athletics:

3 (A) Serves the athlete in an advisory capacity on a matter  
4 related to finances, business pursuits, or career management  
5 decisions, unless the individual is an employee of an educational  
6 institution acting exclusively as an employee of the institution for  
7 the benefit of the institution; or

8 (B) Manages the business affairs of the athlete by providing  
9 assistance with bills, payments, contracts, or taxes; or

10 (iii) In anticipation of representing a student athlete for a  
11 purpose related to the athlete's participation in athletics:

12 (A) Gives consideration to the student athlete or another person;

13 (B) Serves the athlete in an advisory capacity on a matter  
14 related to finances, business pursuits, or career management  
15 decisions; or

16 (C) Manages the business affairs of the athlete by providing  
17 assistance with bills, payments, contracts, or taxes.

18 (b) "Athlete agent" does not include an individual who:

19 (i) Acts solely on behalf of a professional sports team or  
20 organization; or

21 (ii) Is a licensed, registered, or certified professional and  
22 offers or provides services to a student athlete customarily provided  
23 by members of the profession, unless the individual:

24 (A) Also recruits or solicits the athlete to enter into an agency  
25 contract;

26 (B) Also, for compensation, procures employment or offers,  
27 promises, attempts, or negotiates to obtain employment for the  
28 athlete as a professional athlete or member of a professional sports  
29 team or organization; or

30 (C) Receives consideration for providing the services calculated  
31 using a different method than for an individual who is not a student  
32 athlete. ((The term does not include a spouse, parent, sibling,  
33 grandparent, or legal guardian of the student athlete or an  
34 individual acting solely on behalf of a professional sports team or  
35 professional sports organization. The term includes an individual who  
36 represents to the public that the individual is an athlete agent.))

37 (3) "Athletic director" means ((an)) the individual responsible  
38 for administering the overall athletic program of an educational  
39 institution or, if an educational institution has separately  
40 administered athletic programs for male students and female students,

1 the athletic program for males or the athletic program for females,  
2 as appropriate.

3 (4) "Contact" means a communication, direct or indirect, between  
4 an athlete agent and a student((-))athlete, to recruit or solicit the  
5 student((-))athlete to enter into an agency contract.

6 (5) "Educational institution" includes a public or private  
7 elementary school, secondary school, technical or vocational school,  
8 community college, college, and university.

9 (6) "Endorsement contract" means an agreement under which a  
10 student((-))athlete is employed or receives consideration to use on  
11 behalf of the other party any value that the student((-))athlete may  
12 have because of publicity, reputation, following, or fame obtained  
13 because of athletic ability or performance.

14 ((+6)) (7) "Enrolled" means registered for courses and attending  
15 athletic practice or class. "Enrolls" has a corresponding meaning.

16 (8) "Intercollegiate sport" means a sport played at the  
17 collegiate level for which eligibility requirements for participation  
18 by a student((-))athlete are established by a national association  
19 ((for the promotion or regulation of)) that promotes or regulates  
20 collegiate athletics.

21 ((+7)) (9) "Interscholastic sport" means a sport played between  
22 educational institutions that are not community colleges, colleges,  
23 or universities.

24 (10) "Licensed, registered, or certified professional" means an  
25 individual licensed, registered, or certified as an attorney, dealer  
26 in securities, financial planner, insurance agent, real estate broker  
27 or sales agent, tax consultant, accountant, or member of a  
28 profession, other than that of athlete agent, who is licensed,  
29 registered, or certified by the state or a nationally recognized  
30 organization that licenses, registers, or certifies members of the  
31 profession on the basis of experience, education, or testing.

32 (11) "Person" means an individual, estate, business or nonprofit  
33 entity, public corporation, ((business—trust, estate, trust,  
34 partnership, limited liability company, association, joint venture,  
35 or)) government((+)) or governmental subdivision, agency, or

36 instrumentality((+ public corporation+)), or any other legal or  
37 commercial entity.

38 ((+8)) (12) "Professional-sports-services contract" means an  
39 agreement under which an individual is employed as a professional  
40 athlete or agrees to render services as a player on a professional

1 sports team(~~(7)~~) or with a professional sports organization(~~(7, or as~~  
2 ~~a professional athlete)~~).

3 ~~((9))~~ (13) "Record" means information that is inscribed on a  
4 tangible medium or that is stored in an electronic or other medium  
5 and is retrievable in perceivable form.

6 ~~((10))~~ (14) "Recruit or solicit" means the attempt to influence  
7 the choice of an athlete agent by a student athlete or, if the  
8 athlete is a minor, a parent or guardian of the athlete. The term  
9 does not include giving advice on the selection of a particular  
10 athlete agent in a family, coaching, or social situation unless the  
11 individual giving the advice does so because of the receipt or  
12 anticipated receipt of an economic benefit, directly or indirectly,  
13 from the athlete agent.

14 (15) "Sign" means, with present intent to authenticate or adopt a  
15 record:

16 (a) To execute or adopt a tangible symbol; or

17 (b) To attach to or logically associate with the record an  
18 electronic symbol, sound, or process.

19 (16) "State" means a state of the United States, the District of  
20 Columbia, Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, or any  
21 territory or insular possession subject to the jurisdiction of the  
22 United States.

23 ~~((11))~~ (17) "Student(~~(-)~~)athlete" means an individual who is  
24 eligible to attend an educational institution and engages in, is  
25 eligible to engage in, or may be eligible in the future to engage in,  
26 any interscholastic or intercollegiate sport. ~~((11))~~ The term does  
27 not include an individual ~~((is))~~ permanently ineligible to  
28 participate in a particular interscholastic or intercollegiate  
29 sport(~~(, the individual is not a student athlete)~~) for ~~((purposes~~  
30 ~~of))~~ that sport.

31 **Sec. 2.** RCW 19.225.020 and 2002 c 131 s 3 are each amended to  
32 read as follows:

33 By ~~((engaging in the business of))~~ acting as an athlete agent in  
34 this state, a nonresident individual appoints the secretary of state  
35 as the individual's agent ~~((to accept))~~ for service of process in any  
36 civil action in this state related to ~~((the individual's business))~~  
37 acting as an athlete agent in this state.

1       **Sec. 3.** RCW 19.225.030 and 2002 c 131 s 4 are each amended to  
2 read as follows:

3       (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) of this  
4 section, an individual may not act as an athlete agent in this state  
5 unless on the day of initial contact with any student((-))athlete the  
6 athlete agent delivers to the student((-))athlete the athlete agent  
7 disclosure form as required by RCW 19.225.040.

8       (2) An individual may act as an athlete agent before delivering  
9 an athlete agent disclosure form for all purposes except signing an  
10 agency contract if:

11       (a) A student((-))athlete or another person acting on behalf of  
12 the ((~~student~~-))athlete initiates communication with the individual;  
13 and

14       (b) ((~~Within~~)) Not later than seven days after an initial act as  
15 an athlete agent, the individual delivers an athlete agent disclosure  
16 form to the student((-))athlete.

17       (3) An agency contract resulting from conduct in violation of  
18 this section is void((-)), and the athlete agent shall return any  
19 consideration received under the contract.

20       **Sec. 4.** RCW 19.225.040 and 2002 c 131 s 5 are each amended to  
21 read as follows:

22       (1) The athlete agent disclosure form must be in a record  
23 executed in the name of an individual and signed by the athlete agent  
24 under penalty of perjury and, except as otherwise provided in  
25 subsection (2) of this section, must ((~~state or~~)) contain at least  
26 the following:

27       (a) The name of the athlete agent and the following contact  
28 information for the agent:

29       (i) The address of the athlete agent's principal place of  
30 business;

31       (ii) Work and mobile telephone numbers; and

32       (iii) Any means of communicating electronically, including a  
33 facsimile number, email address, and personal and business or  
34 employer web sites;

35       (b) The name of the athlete agent's business or employer, if  
36 applicable, including for each business or employer, its mailing  
37 address, telephone number, organization form, and nature of the  
38 business;

1 (c) ~~((Any))~~ Each social media account with which the athlete  
2 agent or the agent's business or employer is affiliated;

3 (d) Each business or occupation in which the athlete agent  
4 engaged ~~((in by the athlete agent for the))~~ within five years ~~((next~~  
5 preceding)) before the date of execution of the athlete agent  
6 disclosure form, including self-employment and employment by others,  
7 and any professional or occupational license, registration, or  
8 certification held by the agent during that time;

11 (ii) Practical experience as an athlete agent; and

12 (iii) Educational background relating to the athlete agent's

16 (f) The name ~~((, sport, and last known team for each individual))~~  
17 of each student athlete for whom the athlete agent ~~((provided~~

19 ~~((next preceding))~~ before the date of execution of the athlete agent  
20 disclosure form or, if the individual is a minor, the name of the  
21 parent or guardian of the minor, together with the athlete's sport

23 (g) The names and addresses of ~~((all persons who are))~~ each  
24 person that:

25 (i) ~~((With respect to the athlete agent's business if it is not a~~

27 Is a partner, member, officer, manager, associate, or profit sharer

31 (ii) ~~((With respect to a corporation employing the athlete agent,~~  
32 ~~the officers, directors, and any shareholder of the corporation with~~

34 corporation employing the athlete agent or a shareholder having an

36 (h) A description of the status of any application by the athlete  
37 agent, or any person named under (g) of this subsection, for a state  
38 or federal business, professional, or occupational license, other  
39 than as an athlete agent, from a state or federal agency, including

1 any denial, refusal to renew, suspension, withdrawal, or termination  
2 of the license and any reprimand or censure related to the license;

3 (i) Whether the athlete agent or any other person named pursuant  
4 to (g) of this subsection has pleaded guilty or no contest to, has  
5 been convicted of, or has charges pending for, a ((crime that, if  
6 committed in this state, would be a)) felony or other crime involving  
7 moral turpitude, and ((identify)), if so, identification of:

8 (i) The crime;

9 ((+)) (ii) The law enforcement agency involved; and

10 (iii) If applicable, the date of the conviction and the fine or  
11 penalty imposed;

12 (j) Whether, within fifteen years before the date of execution of  
13 the athlete agent disclosure form, the athlete agent, or any person  
14 named under (g) of this subsection, has been a defendant or  
15 respondent in a civil proceeding, including a proceeding seeking an  
16 adjudication of legal incompetence and, if so, the date and a full  
17 explanation of each proceeding;

18 (k) Whether the athlete agent, or any person named under (g) of  
19 this subsection, has an unsatisfied judgment or a judgment of  
20 continuing effect, including maintenance or a domestic order in the  
21 nature of child support, which is not current at the date of  
22 execution of the athlete agent disclosure form;

23 (l) Whether, within ten years before the execution of the athlete  
24 agent disclosure form, the athlete agent, or any person named under  
25 (g) of this subsection, was adjudicated bankrupt or was an owner of a  
26 business that was adjudicated bankrupt;

27 (m) Whether there has been any administrative or judicial  
28 determination that the athlete agent, or any other person named  
29 ((pursuant to)) under (g) of this subsection ((has)), made a false,  
30 misleading, deceptive, or fraudulent representation;

31 ((+j) Any) (n) Each instance in which the conduct of the athlete  
32 agent, or any other person named ((pursuant to)) under (g) of this  
33 subsection, resulted in the imposition of a sanction, suspension, or  
34 declaration of ineligibility to participate in an interscholastic  
35 ((or)), intercollegiate, or professional athletic event on a  
36 student((-))athlete or a sanction on an educational institution;

37 ((+k) Any) (o) Each sanction, suspension, or disciplinary action  
38 taken against the athlete agent, or any other person named ((pursuant  
39 to)) under (g) of this subsection, arising out of occupational or  
40 professional conduct; ((and



1       ~~(1))~~ (p) Whether there has been ~~((any))~~ a denial of an  
2 application for, suspension or revocation of, ~~((or))~~ refusal to  
3 renew, or abandonment of, the registration ~~((or licensure))~~ of the  
4 athlete agent, or any other person named ~~((pursuant to))~~ under (g) of  
5 this subsection, as an athlete agent in any state;

6       (q) Each state in which the applicant currently is registered as  
7 an athlete agent or has applied to be registered as an athlete agent;  
8 and

9       (r) If the athlete agent is certified or registered by a  
10 professional league or players association:

11       (i) The name of the league or association;

12       (ii) The date of certification or registration, and the date of  
13 expiration of the certification or registration, if any; and

14       (iii) If applicable, the date of any denial of an application  
15 for, suspension or revocation of, refusal to renew, withdrawal of, or  
16 termination of, the certification or registration or any reprimand or  
17 censure related to the certification or registration.

18       (2) Instead of delivering an athlete agent disclosure form  
19 pursuant to subsection (1) of this section, an individual who ~~((has~~  
20 ~~submitted an application for, and received a certificate of or a~~  
21 ~~renewal of a certificate of, registration))~~ is registered or  
22 ~~((licensure))~~ licensed as an athlete agent in another state may  
23 ~~((submit a copy of the application and a valid certificate of~~  
24 ~~registration or licensure from the other state in lieu of submitting~~  
25 ~~an athlete agent disclosure form in the form prescribed pursuant to~~  
26 ~~subsection (1) of this section, but only if the application to the~~

9 (1) Pleaded guilty or no contest to, has been convicted of, or  
10 has charges pending for, a ((~~crime that, if committed in this state,~~  
11 would be a)) felony or other crime involving moral turpitude;

12 (2) Made a materially false, misleading, deceptive, or fraudulent  
13 representation as an athlete agent or in the application for  
14 licensure or registration as an athlete agent in another state;

15 (3) Engaged in conduct prohibited by RCW 19.225.100;

16 (4) Had a registration or licensure as an athlete agent  
17 suspended, revoked, or denied ((~~or been refused renewal of~~  
18 ~~registration or licensure~~)) in any state; ((~~or~~))

19 (5) Been refused renewal of registration as an athlete agent in  
20 any state; or

21 (6) Engaged in conduct ((~~or failed to engage in conduct the~~  
22 ~~consequence of which was that~~)) resulting in imposition of a  
23 sanction, suspension, or declaration of ineligibility to participate  
24 in an interscholastic ((~~or~~)), intercollegiate, or professional  
25 athletic event ((~~was imposed~~)) on a student((-))athlete or a sanction  
26 on an educational institution.

27 **Sec. 6.** RCW 19.225.060 and 2002 c 131 s 7 are each amended to  
28 read as follows:

29 (1) An agency contract must be in a record signed by the parties.

30 (2) An agency contract must ((~~state or~~)) contain:

31 (a) The amount and method of calculating the consideration to be  
32 paid by the student((-))athlete for services to be provided by the  
33 athlete agent under the contract and any other consideration the  
34 athlete agent has received or will receive from any other source for  
35 entering into the contract or for providing the services;

36 (b) The name of any person other than the athlete agent who will  
37 be compensated because the student((-))athlete signed the ((~~agency~~))  
38 contract;

1 (c) A description of any expenses ~~((that))~~ the  
2 student~~((-))~~athlete agrees to reimburse;

3 (d) A description of the services to be provided to the  
4 ~~((student-))~~athlete;

5 (e) The duration of the contract; and

6 (f) The date of execution.

7 (3) Subject to subsection (7) of this section, an agency contract  
8 must contain(~~(, in close proximity to the signature of the student-~~  
9 athlete~~,~~)) a conspicuous notice in boldface type (~~(in capital letters~~  
10 stating)) and in substantially the following form:

12 **IF YOU SIGN THIS CONTRACT:**

13 (a) **YOU MAY LOSE YOUR ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE AS A**

15 (b) **BOTH YOU AND YOUR ATHLETE AGENT (~~((ARE REQUIRED TO TELL))~~) MUST**  
16 **NOTIFY YOUR ATHLETIC DIRECTOR, IF YOU HAVE AN ATHLETIC DIRECTOR, AT**  
17 **LEAST SEVENTY-TWO HOURS PRIOR TO ENTERING INTO AN AGENCY CONTRACT**  
18 **THAT YOU INTEND TO ENTER INTO THIS CONTRACT AND PROVIDE THE NAME AND**  
19 **CONTACT INFORMATION OF THE ATHLETE AGENT AND AGAIN WITHIN SEVENTY-TWO**  
20 **HOURS AFTER ENTERING INTO AN AGENCY CONTRACT THAT YOU HAVE ENTERED**  
21 **INTO THIS CONTRACT AND PROVIDE THE NAME AND CONTACT INFORMATION OF**  
22 **THE ATHLETE AGENT; AND**

23 (c) **YOU MAY CANCEL THIS CONTRACT WITHIN (~~((FOURTEEN))~~) 14 DAYS**  
24 **AFTER SIGNING IT. CANCELLATION OF (~~((THE))~~) THIS CONTRACT MAY NOT**  
25 **REINSTATE YOUR ELIGIBILITY AS A STUDENT ATHLETE IN YOUR SPORT.**

26 (4) ~~((A copy of the athlete agent disclosure form delivered to~~  
27 ~~the student-athlete shall be attached to the agency contract.)) An~~  
28 ~~agency contract must be accompanied by a separate record signed by~~  
29 ~~the student athlete or, if the athlete is a minor, the parent or~~  
30 ~~guardian of the athlete acknowledging that signing the contract may~~  
31 ~~result in the loss of the athlete's eligibility to participate in the~~  
32 ~~athlete's sport.~~

33 (5) ~~((An agency contract that does not conform to this section is~~  
34 ~~voidable by the student-athlete.)) A student athlete or, if the~~  
35 ~~athlete is a minor, the parent or guardian of the athlete may void an~~  
36 ~~agency contract that does not conform to this section. If the~~  
37 ~~contract is voided, any consideration received from the athlete agent~~  
38 ~~under the contract to induce entering into the contract is not~~  
39 ~~required to be returned.~~

1       ~~((The athlete agent shall give a copy of the signed agency~~  
2 ~~contract to the student athlete at the time of signing.))~~ At the time  
3 an agency contract is executed, the athlete agent shall give the  
4 student athlete or, if the athlete is a minor, the parent or guardian  
5 of the athlete a copy in a record of the contract and the separate  
6 acknowledgment required in subsection (4) of this section.

7       (7) If a student athlete is a minor, an agency contract must be  
8 signed by the parent or guardian of the minor and the notice required  
9 by subsection (3) of this section must be revised accordingly.

10       **Sec. 7.** RCW 19.225.070 and 2002 c 131 s 8 are each amended to  
11 read as follows:

12       (1) ~~((At least))~~ In this section, "communicating or attempting to  
13 communicate" means contacting or attempting to contact by an in-  
14 person meeting, a record, or any other method that conveys or  
15 attempts to convey a message.

16       (2) Not later than seventy-two hours prior to entering into an  
17 agency contract and again not later than seventy-two hours after  
18 entering into an agency contract, or before the next scheduled  
19 athletic event in which the student athlete may participate,  
20 whichever occurs first, the athlete agent shall give notice in a  
21 record of the existence of the contract ~~((and shall provide a copy of~~  
22 ~~the athlete agent disclosure form))~~ to the athletic director of the  
23 educational institution at which the ~~((student-))~~athlete is enrolled  
24 or at which the athlete agent has reasonable grounds to believe the  
25 ~~((student-))~~athlete intends to enroll.

26       ~~((2) Within seventy two hours after entering into an agency~~  
27 ~~contract or before the next scheduled athletic event in which the~~  
28 ~~student athlete may participate, whichever occurs first, the athlete~~

38 ~~institution at which the student athlete is enrolled.~~

2 into an agency contract and again not later than seventy-two hours  
3 after entering into an agency contract or before the next scheduled  
4 athletic event in which the student((-)athlete may participate,  
5 whichever occurs first, the ((student-)athlete shall inform the  
6 athletic director of the educational institution at which the  
7 ((student-)athlete is enrolled that ((he or she)) the athlete has  
8 entered into an agency contract and ((shall provide a copy of the
