1 AN ACT Relating to providing fee immunity for certain city, town,
2 and county water facilities; and adding a new section to chapter
3 35.21 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 35.21
6 RCW to read as follows:

7 Any city, town, or county may:

8 (1) Plan for, construct, operate, and maintain moorage facilities
9 as defined in RCW 53.08.310 for recreational boating activities on
10 land and overwater structures owned or otherwise controlled by a
11 city, town, or county;

12 (2) Impose a fee under its existing police power in an amount up
13 to twenty dollars daily or one hundred dollars annually for access to
14 and use of the moorage facility. Every two years after the effective
15 date of this section, the maximum daily charge of twenty dollars must
16 increase by one dollar and the maximum annual charge of one hundred
17 dollars must increase by five dollars. The immunity provided under
18 RCW 4.24.210 applies notwithstanding the imposition of fees
19 authorized by this section.
