- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 69.22.050 and 2011 c 281 s 5 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1) The <u>annual</u> gross sales of cottage food products may not
  7 exceed ((an <u>annual amount set by the department</u>)) <u>twenty-five</u>
  8 <u>thousand dollars</u>. The determination of the maximum annual gross sales
  9 must be computed on the basis of the amount of gross sales within or
  10 at a particular domestic residence and may not be computed on a per
  11 person basis within or at an individual domestic residence.
