1 AN ACT Relating to allowing counties to create guardianship 2 courthouse facilitator programs; and adding a new section to chapter 3 11.88 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 11.88 6 RCW to read as follows:

7 A county may create a guardianship courthouse facilitator program to provide basic services to pro se litigants in guardianship cases. 8 The legislative authority of any county may impose user fees or may 9 impose a surcharge of up to twenty dollars, or both, on superior 10 11 court cases filed under chapters 11.88, 11.90, 11.92, and 73.36 RCW to pay for the expenses of the guardianship courthouse facilitator 12 program. Fees collected under this section shall be collected and 13 14 deposited in the same manner as other county funds are collected and and shall be maintained in 15 deposited, а separate guardianship 16 courthouse facilitator account to be used as provided in this 17 section.
