1 AN ACT Relating to water banking; amending RCW 90.42.130; and 2 adding a new section to chapter 90.42 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 90.42.130 and 2014 c 76 s 9 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (((+1)))The department shall seek input from agricultural 7 agencies, organizations, federal tribal governments, local governments, watershed groups, conservation groups, and developers on 8 water banking, including water banking procedures and identification 9 10 of areas in Washington ((state)) where water banking could assist in 11 providing water supplies for instream and out-of-stream uses.

12 (((2) The department shall maintain information on its web site 13 regarding water banking, including information on water banks and 14 related programs in various areas of the state.))

15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 90.42 16 RCW to read as follows:

(1)(a) The department must maintain information on its web site regarding water banking, including information on water banks and related programs in various areas of the state.

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1 (b) The information maintained on the department's web site under 2 this subsection must include a schedule or table for each water bank 3 that shows:

(i) The amount charged for mitigation, including any fees;

5 (ii) If applicable, the priority date of the water rights made 6 available for mitigation;

(iii) The amount of water made available for mitigation;

8 (iv) If applicable, any geographic areas in the state where the 9 department may issue permits or other approvals to use the water 10 rights associated with the water bank as mitigation;

(v) The processes utilized by the water bank to obtain approval from the department, or any other applicable governmental agency, to use the water rights as mitigation for new water uses; and

14 (vi) The nature of the ownership interest of the water right 15 available to be conveyed to the landowner and whether the ownership 16 interest will be recorded on the title.

17 (2) The department must update the schedule or table required 18 under this section on a quarterly basis, using information provided 19 to the department by the operator of each water bank. Any person 20 operating a water bank in Washington must provide the information 21 required under this section to the department upon request.
