House Bills

HB 2136-S by House Committee on Finance (originally sponsored by Representative Carlyle)

Concerning comprehensive marijuana market reforms to ensure a well-regulated and taxed marijuana market in Washington state.

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Addresses comprehensive marijuana market reforms.

HB 2193 by Representatives Robinson, Sells, and Kagi

Modifying the property tax exemption for property used to provide housing for eligible persons with developmental disabilities.

Provides a property tax exemption for adult family homes occupied by eligible persons with developmental disabilities, if at least seventy-five percent of the eligible persons have a low income.
