EFFECT: Provides that, in order to enter into a valid  
surrogacy agreement, a woman acting as a surrogate must not be  
receiving or eligible to receive public assistance or benefits under  
state or federal programs such as Temporary Assistance for Needy  
Families, the Basic Food Program, Medicaid, or other similar  
programs.

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
