 - <u>EFFECT:</u> Establishes that any person growing industrial hemp without a license may be subject to a penalty of up to \$25,000 per location. Requires that the department of agriculture impose penalties in accordance with the administrative procedure act. Allows the department of agriculture to enter public or private premises to obtain samples.
