### HB 1734

**Brief Description:** Authorizing reimbursement for substitute teachers participating in activities of the Washington state professional educator standards board to carry out its powers and duties.

**Sponsors:** Representatives Lovick, Hargrove, Stonier, Muri, Ortiz-Self and Pollet; by request of Professional Educator Standards Board.

**Background:**

In order to further education in the state, one or more certificated or classified school district employees may be requested to serve on a committee formed by the Legislature, the Superintendent of Public Instruction (SPI), or the State Board of Education. If substitutes would be needed during a certificated or classified employees' time of service on a committee, the SPI must make payments to the employees' school districts using funds appropriated by the Legislature for the use of the common schools.

**Summary of Bill:**

The SPI must make payments to the employees' school district for substitutes needed because the Professional Educator Standard Board requested certificated or classified school district employees to serve on a committee that furthers education in the state.
