- AN ACT Relating to attempting to elude a pursuing police vehicle; amending RCW 46.61.024; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.024 and 2010 c 8 s 9065 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- (1) Any driver of a motor vehicle who willfully fails or refuses 6 7 to immediately bring his or her vehicle to a stop and who drives his or her vehicle in a reckless manner while attempting to elude a 8 pursuing police vehicle, after being given a visual or audible signal 9 10 to bring the vehicle to a stop, shall be guilty of a class C felony. The signal given by the police officer may be by hand, voice, 11 12 emergency light, or siren. The officer giving such a signal shall be 13 in uniform and the vehicle shall be equipped with lights and sirens. 14 A "pursuing police vehicle" includes a police vehicle that, after signaling the driver of a motor vehicle to immediately bring his or 15
- 16 her vehicle to a stop, does not initiate vehicular pursuit or
- 17 <u>terminates vehicular pursuit.</u>
- 18 (2) It is an affirmative defense to this section which must be 19 established by a preponderance of the evidence that: (a) A reasonable 20 person would not believe that the signal to stop was given by a

1 police officer; and (b) driving after the signal to stop was 2 reasonable under the circumstances.

(3) The license or permit to drive or any nonresident driving privilege of a person convicted of a violation of this section shall be revoked by the department of licensing.
