State of Washington 65th Legislature 2017 3rd Special Session
By Representative Tharinger

1 AN ACT Relating to providing continuity for state-funded capital
2 budget activities by making 2015-2017 appropriations for supplemental
3 capital projects, 2017-2019 appropriations for previously authorized
4 capital projects, and 2017-2019 appropriations for oversight and
5 review of projects and facilities; amending RCW 70.340.130 and
6 28B.10.027; amending 2015 3rd sp.s. c 3 ss 1002, 1026, 1028, 6005,
7 3118, 3101, 3198, 3200, 3202, 3204, 3197, 3188, 3187, and 5034
8 (uncodified); amending 2016 sp.s. c 35 ss 1008, 1015, 1016, 2011,
9 3018, and 5004 (uncodified); reenacting and amending RCW 43.19.501;
10 adding new sections to 2015 3rd sp.s. c 3 (uncodified); creating new
11 sections; making appropriations; providing an expiration date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) A capital budget is hereby adopted
15 and, subject to the provisions set forth in this act, the several
16 dollar amounts hereinafter specified, or so much thereof as shall be
17 sufficient to accomplish the purposes designated, are hereby
18 appropriated and authorized to be incurred for capital projects
19 during the period beginning with the effective date of this act and
20 ending June 30, 2019, out of the several funds specified in this act.

1 (2) The definitions in this subsection apply throughout this act
2 unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

3 (a) "Fiscal year 2018" or "FY 2018" means the period beginning
4 July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018.

5 (b) "Fiscal year 2019" or "FY 2019" means the period beginning
6 July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019.

7 (c) "Lapse" or "revert" means the amount shall return to an
8 unappropriated status.

9 (d) "Provided solely" means the specified amount may be spent
10 only for the specified purpose.

11 (3) Unless otherwise specifically authorized in this act, any
12 portion of an amount provided solely for a specified purpose that is
13 not expended subject to the specified conditions and limitations to
14 fulfill the specified purpose shall lapse.

15 (4) The amounts shown under the headings "Prior Biennia," "Future
16 Biennia," and "Total" in this act are for informational purposes only
17 and do not constitute legislative approval of these amounts. "Prior
18 biennia" typically refers to the immediate prior biennium for
19 reappropriations, but may refer to multiple biennia in the case of
20 specific projects. A "future biennia" amount is an estimate of what
21 may be appropriated for the project or program in the 2019-2021
22 biennium and the following three biennia; an amount of zero does not
23 necessarily constitute legislative intent to not provide funding for
24 the project or program in the future.

25 (5) "Reappropriations" in this act are appropriations and, unless
26 the context clearly provides otherwise, are subject to the relevant
27 conditions and limitations applicable to appropriations.
28 Reappropriations shall be limited to the unexpended balances
29 remaining on June 30, 2017, from previous biennial appropriations for
30 each project.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7001.** To ensure that major construction
4 projects are carried out in accordance with legislative and executive
5 intent, appropriations in this act in excess of \$5,000,000, or
6 \$10,000,000 for higher education institutions, may not be expended or
7 encumbered until the office of financial management has reviewed and
8 approved the agency's predesign. The predesign document must include,
9 but not be limited to, program, site, and cost analysis, and an
10 analysis of the life-cycle costs of the alternatives explored, in
11 accordance with the predesign manual adopted by the office of
12 financial management. The results of life-cycle cost analysis must be
13 a primary consideration in the selection of a building design.
14 Construction may proceed only upon providing to the office of
15 financial management the life-cycle costs. To improve monitoring of
16 major construction projects, progress reports must be submitted by
17 the agency administering the project to the office of financial
18 management and to the fiscal committees of the house of
19 representatives and senate. Reports must be submitted on July 1st and
20 December 31st each year in a format to be developed by the office of
21 financial management.

22 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7002.** (1) The legislature finds that use of
23 life-cycle cost analysis will aid public entities, architects,
24 engineers, and contractors in making design and construction
25 decisions that positively impact both the initial construction cost
26 and the ongoing operating and maintenance cost of a project. To
27 ensure that the total cost of a project is accounted for and the most
28 reasonable and cost efficient design is used, agencies shall develop
29 life-cycle costs for any construction project over \$10,000,000. The
30 life-cycle costs must represent the present value sum of capital
31 costs, installation costs, operating costs, and maintenance costs
32 over the life expectancy of the project. The legislature further
33 finds the most effective approach to the life-cycle cost analysis is
34 to integrate it into the early part of the design process.

35 (2) Agencies shall develop a minimum of three project
36 alternatives for use in the life-cycle cost analysis. These
37 alternatives must be both distinctly different and viable solutions
38 to the issue being addressed. The chosen alternative must be the most

1 reasonable and cost-effective solution. A brief description of each

3 life-cycle cost analysis section of the predesign.

4 (3) The office of financial management shall: (a) Make available
5 a life-cycle cost model to be used for analysis; (b) in consultation
6 with the department of enterprise services, provide assistance in
7 using the life-cycle cost model; and (c) update the life-cycle cost
8 model annually including assumptions for inflation rates, discount
9 rates, and energy rates.

10 (4) Agencies shall consider architectural and engineering firms'
11 and general contractors' experience using life-cycle costs, operating
12 costs, and energy efficiency measures when selecting an architectural
13 and engineering firm, or when selecting contractors using alternative
14 contracting methods.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7003.** To improve monitoring of major
16 construction projects, progress reports must be submitted by the
17 agency administering the project to the office of financial
18 management and to the fiscal committees of the house of
19 representatives and senate. Reports must be submitted on July 1st and
20 December 31st each year in a format to be determined by the office of
21 financial management.

22 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7004.** (1) Allotments for appropriations in
23 this act shall be provided in accordance with the capital project
24 review requirements adopted by the office of financial management and
25 in compliance with RCW 43.88.110. Projects that will be employing
26 alternative public works construction procedures under chapter 39.10
27 RCW are subject to the allotment procedures defined in this section
28 and RCW 43.88.110.

29 (2) Each project is defined as proposed in the legislative budget
30 notes or in the governor's budget document.

31 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7005.** (1) The office of financial management
32 may authorize a transfer of appropriation authority provided for a
33 capital project that is in excess of the amount required for the
34 completion of such project to another capital project for which the
35 appropriation is insufficient. No such transfer may be used to expand
36 the capacity of any facility beyond that intended in making the
37 appropriation. Such transfers may be effected only between capital

1 appropriations to a specific department, commission, agency, or
2 institution of higher education and only between capital projects
3 that are funded from the same fund or account. No transfers may occur
4 between projects to local government agencies except where the grants
5 are provided within a single omnibus appropriation and where such
6 transfers are specifically authorized by the implementing statutes
7 that govern the grants.

8 (2) The office of financial management may find that an amount is
9 in excess of the amount required for the completion of a project only
10 if: (a) The project as defined in the notes to the budget document is
11 substantially complete and there are funds remaining; or (b) bids
12 have been let on a project and it appears to a substantial certainty
13 that the project as defined in the notes to the budget document can
14 be completed within the biennium for less than the amount
15 appropriated in this act.

16 (3) For the purposes of this section, the intent is that each
17 project be defined as proposed to the legislature in the governor's
18 budget document, unless it clearly appears from the legislative
19 history that the legislature intended to define the scope of a
20 project in a different way.

21 (4) A report of any transfer effected under this section, except
22 emergency projects or any transfer under \$250,000, shall be filed
23 with the legislative fiscal committees of the senate and house of
24 representatives by the office of financial management at least thirty
25 days before the date the transfer is effected. The office of
26 financial management shall report all emergency or smaller transfers
27 within thirty days from the date of transfer.

28 (5) The transfer authority granted in this section does not apply
29 to appropriations for projects for the state parks and recreation
30 commission. Appropriations for commission projects may be spent only
31 for the specified projects, and funding may not be transferred from
32 one commission project to another or from other sources to a
33 commission project.

34 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7006.** (1) It is expected that projects be
35 ready to proceed in a timely manner depending on the type or phase of
36 the project or program that is the subject of the appropriation in
37 this act. Except for major projects that customarily may take more
38 than two biennia to complete from predesign to the end of
39 construction, or large infrastructure grant or loan programs

1 supporting projects that often take more than two biennia to
2 complete, the legislature generally does not intend to reappropriate

17 of higher education, shall allot and report full-time equivalent
18 staff for capital projects in a manner comparable to staff reporting
19 for operating expenditures.

20 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7008.** Executive Order No. 05-05,
21 archaeological and cultural resources, was issued effective November
22 10, 2005. Agencies shall comply with the requirements set forth in
23 this executive order.

24 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7009.** FOR THE ARTS COMMISSION—ART WORK
25 ALLOWANCE. (1) One-half of one percent of moneys appropriated in this
26 act for original construction of school plant facilities is provided
27 solely for the purposes of RCW 28A.335.210.

28 (2) One-half of one percent of moneys appropriated in this act
29 for original construction or any major renovation or remodel work
30 exceeding \$200,000 by colleges or universities is provided solely for
31 the purposes of RCW 28B.10.027.

32 (3) One-half of one percent of moneys appropriated in this act
33 for original construction of any public building by a state agency
34 identified in RCW 43.17.020 is provided solely for the purposes of

36 (4) At least eighty-five percent of the moneys spent by the
37 Washington state arts commission during the 2017-2019 biennium for

37 institutions of higher education, integral to or attached to a public
38 building or structure of institutions of higher education, detached
39 within or outside a public building or structure of institutions of

1 higher education, part of a portable exhibition or collection, part
2 of a temporary exhibition, or loaned or exhibited in other public
3 facilities.

4 (4) In addition to the cost of the works of art, the one-half of
5 one percent of the appropriation shall be used to provide for the
6 administration of the visual arts program, including conservation of
7 the state art collection, by the Washington state arts commission and
8 all costs for installation of the work of art. For the purpose of
9 this section building shall not include sheds, warehouses, and other
10 buildings of a temporary nature.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7011.** To carry out the provisions of this
12 act, the governor may assign responsibility for predesign, design,
13 construction, and other related activities to any appropriate agency.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7012.** If any federal moneys appropriated by
15 this act for capital projects are not received by the state, the
16 department or agency to which the moneys were appropriated may
17 replace the federal moneys with funds available from private or local
18 sources. No replacement may occur under this section without the
19 prior approval of the director of financial management in
20 consultation with the senate ways and means committee and the house
21 of representatives capital budget committee.

22 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7013.** (1) Unless otherwise stated, for all
23 appropriations under this act that require a match of nonstate money
24 or in-kind contributions, the following requirement, consistent with
25 RCW 43.88.150, shall apply: Expenditures of state money shall be
26 timed so that the state share of project expenditures never exceeds
27 the intended state share of total project costs.

28 (2) Provision of the full amount of required matching funds is
29 not required to permit the expenditure of capital budget
30 appropriations for phased projects if a proportional amount of the
31 required matching funds is provided for each distinct, identifiable
32 phase of the project.

33 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7014.** NONTAXABLE AND TAXABLE BOND PROCEEDS.
34 Portions of the appropriation authority granted by this act from the
35 state building construction account, or any other account receiving
36 bond proceeds, may be transferred to the state taxable building

1 construction account as deemed necessary by the state finance
2 committee to comply with the federal internal revenue service rules
3 and regulations pertaining to the use of nontaxable bond proceeds.
4 Portions of prior authorized general obligation bond proceeds for
5 deposit into the state taxable building construction account that are
6 in excess of amounts required to comply with the federal internal
7 revenue service rules and regulations shall be deposited into the
8 state building construction account. The state treasurer shall submit
9 written notification to the director of financial management if it is
10 determined that a shift of appropriation authority between the state
11 building construction account, or any other account receiving bond
12 proceeds, and the state taxable building construction account is
13 necessary, or that a shift of appropriation authority from the state
14 taxable building construction account to the state building
15 construction account may be made.

16 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7015.** COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN NONTAXABLE AND
17 TAXABLE BOND PROCEEDS. Portions of the appropriation authority
18 granted by this act from the Columbia river basin water supply
19 development account may be transferred to the Columbia river basin
20 taxable bond water supply development account as deemed necessary by
21 the state finance committee to comply with the federal internal
22 revenue service rules and regulations pertaining to the use of
23 nontaxable bond proceeds. The state treasurer shall submit written
24 notification to the director of financial management if it is
25 determined that a shift of appropriation authority between the
26 Columbia river basin water supply development account and the
27 Columbia river basin taxable bond water supply development account is
28 necessary, or that a shift of appropriation authority from the
29 Columbia river basin taxable bond water supply development account to
30 the Columbia river basin water supply development account may be
31 made.

32 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7016.** (1) Funds appropriated in this act for
33 minor works may not be allotted until final project lists are
34 submitted to the office of financial management. Revisions to the
35 project lists are allowed for projects not anticipated at the time of
36 budget development but must be submitted to the office of financial
37 management, the house of representatives capital budget committee,
38 and the senate ways and means committee for review and comment and

1 must include an explanation of variances from the prior lists before
2 funds may be expended on the revisions. Any project list revisions
3 must be approved by the office of financial management before funds
4 may be expended from the minor works appropriation.

5 (2)(a) Minor works project lists are single line appropriations
6 that include multiple projects of a similar nature and that are
7 valued between \$25,000 and \$1,000,000 each, with the exception of
8 higher education minor works projects that may be valued up to
9 \$2,000,000. All projects must meet the criteria included in this
10 subsection (2)(a). These projects should be completed within two
11 years of the appropriation with the funding provided. Agencies are
12 prohibited from including projects on their minor works lists that
13 are a phase of a larger project, and that if combined over a
14 continuous period of time, would exceed \$1,000,000, or \$2,000,000 for
15 higher education minor works projects. Improvements for accessibility
16 in compliance with the Americans with disabilities act may be
17 included in any of the minor works categories.

18 (b) Minor works appropriations may not be used for the following:
19 Studies, except for technical or engineering reviews or designs that
20 lead directly to and support a project on the same minor works list;
21 planning; design outside the scope of work on a minor works list;
22 movable, temporary, and traditionally funded operating equipment not
23 in compliance with the equipment criteria established by the office
24 of financial management; software not dedicated to control of a
25 specialized system; moving expenses; land or facility acquisition;
26 rolling stock; computers; or to supplement funding for projects with
27 funding shortfalls unless expressly authorized. The office of
28 financial management may make an exception to the limitations
29 described in this subsection (2)(b) for exigent circumstances after
30 notifying the legislative fiscal committees and waiting ten days for
31 comments by the legislature regarding the proposed exception.

32 (c) Minor works preservation projects may include program
33 improvements of no more than twenty-five percent of the individual

35 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7017.** To the extent that any appropriation
36 authorizes expenditures of state funds from the state building
37 construction account, or from any other capital project account in
38 the state treasury, for a capital project or program that is
39 specified to be funded with proceeds from the sale of bonds, the

2 program made prior to the issue date of the applicable bonds are

9 subsection.

13 (ii) The speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint
14 one member from each of the two largest caucuses of the house of

16 capital budget and education.

17 (iii) The president of the senate and the speaker of the house of
18 representatives jointly shall ensure that at least three of the eight
19 members appointed pursuant to (a)(i) and (ii) of this subsection
20 serve legislative districts located east of the crest of the Cascade
21 mountains.

22 (iv) The chair of the task force selected pursuant to (b) of this
23 subsection may appoint one additional member representing large
24 school districts and one additional member representing small, rural
25 school districts as voting members of the task force.

26 (b) The task force shall choose its chair from among its
27 membership. The chair of the house of representatives committee on
28 capital budget shall convene the initial meeting of the task force.
29 All meetings of the task force must be scheduled and conducted in
30 accordance with the requirements of both the senate and the house of
31 representatives.

32 (2) The task force shall review the following issues:

33 (a) Improvements to state financial assistance for K-12 school
34 construction to be implemented over several fiscal biennia;

35 (b) Utilization of school spaces for multiple purposes;

36 (c) School design and construction approaches that support
37 effective teaching and learning by delivering education through
38 innovative, sustainable, cost-effective, and enduring design and
39 construction methods; and

1 (d) Recent reports on school construction, including but not
2 limited to the school construction cost study from the educational
3 service district 112 and the efforts of collecting inventory and
4 condition of schools data by the Washington state university
5 extension energy office.

6 (3) In consideration of the findings pursuant to subsection (2)
7 of this section, the task force must recommend a state school
8 construction financial assistance program that:

9 (a) Supports the construction and preservation of schools; and

10 (b) Balances the state and local share of school construction and
11 preservation costs considering local school districts' financial
12 capacity, based on measures of relative wealth recommended pursuant
13 to subsection (4)(b) of this section, and the state's limited bond
14 capacity and common school trust land revenue.

15 (4) In making recommendations pursuant to subsection (3) of this
16 section, the task force must, at a minimum, also recommend:

17 (a) A methodology to project needs for state financial assistance
18 for school construction and preservation over a ten-year period;

19 (b) Measures of relative wealth of a school district, including
20 but not limited to assessed land value per student, eligible free and
21 reduced price meal enrollments, income per capita per school
22 district, and costs of construction;

23 (c) Education specifications recognized by the state for the
24 purpose of providing guidance to school districts when designing
25 school construction projects;

26 (d) A capital asset model for K-12 school construction that
27 considers space and usage needs to calculate construction assistance
28 for:

29 (i) New schools to accommodate enrollment growth;

30 (ii) Major modernization projects to address aging facilities;

31 (iii) Replacement and renewal of major building systems based on
32 achieving lowest life-cycle building costs, provided that standards
33 of routine maintenance are achieved by local districts; and

34 (iv) Specialized facility improvements including but not limited
35 to STEM facilities, career and technical education facilities, skills
36 centers, and computer labs; and

37 (e) Alternative means to fund and accommodate increased classroom
38 capacity to meet K-3 class-size reduction objectives.

1 (5)(a) Staff support for the task force must be provided by the
2 senate committee services and the house of representatives office of
3 program research.

4 (b) The office of the superintendent of public instruction and
5 the office of financial management shall cooperate with the task
6 force and maintain liaison representatives, who are nonvoting
7 members.

8 (c) The task force, where appropriate, may consult with
9 individuals from public schools or related organizations or ask the
10 individuals to establish a committee for technical advice and
11 assistance. Members of such an advisory committee are not entitled to
12 expense reimbursement.

13 (6) Legislative members of the task force are reimbursed for
14 travel expenses in accordance with RCW 44.04.120. Nonlegislative
15 members are not entitled to be reimbursed for travel expenses if they
16 are elected officials or are participating on behalf of an employer,
17 governmental entity, or other organization. Any reimbursement for
18 other nonlegislative members is subject to chapter 43.03 RCW.

19 (7) The expenses of the task force must be paid jointly by the
20 senate and the house of representatives. Task force expenditures and
21 meetings are subject to approval by the senate facilities and
22 operations committee and the house of representatives executive rules
23 committee, or their successor committees.

24 (8) The task force must report its preliminary findings and
25 recommendations to the appropriate committees of the legislature by
26 December 1, 2017. The task force must report its final findings and
27 recommendations to the governor, the superintendent of public
28 instruction, and the appropriate committees of the legislature by
29 October 1, 2018.

30 (9) This section expires June 30, 2019.

31 **Sec. 7019.** RCW 43.19.501 and 2016 c 202 s 58 are each reenacted
32 and amended to read as follows:

33 The Thurston county capital facilities account is created in the
34 state treasury. The account is subject to the appropriation and

10 NEW SECTION. Sec. 7020. If any provision of this act or its
11 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
12 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
13 persons or circumstances is not affected.

14 NEW SECTION. Sec. 7021. This act is necessary for the immediate
15 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of
16 the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes
17 effect immediately.
