1 AN ACT Relating to a database of pharmacies offering vaccines and  
2 self-administered hormonal contraceptives through collaborative drug  
3 therapy agreements; adding a new section to chapter 43.70 RCW; and  
4 adding a new section to chapter 18.64 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.70  
7 RCW to read as follows:

8 (1) By July 1, 2019, the department shall establish a searchable  
9 database available on its web site of pharmacies that have one or  
10 more pharmacists on staff with collaborative drug therapy agreements  
11 to prescribe vaccines or self-administered hormonal contraceptives.  
12 The database must include:

13 (a) The name and location of every pharmacy in the state with one  
14 or more pharmacists on staff that through a collaborative drug  
15 agreement prescribe:

16 (i) Vaccines; or

17 (ii) Self-administered hormonal contraceptives;

18 (b) A listing, by pharmacy, of the general categories and types  
19 of vaccines and self-administered hormonal contraceptives, as  
20 determined by the pharmacy quality assurance commission, that one or  
21 more pharmacists on staff at each pharmacy in (a) of this subsection

1 are authorized to prescribe under a collaborative drug therapy  
2 agreement; and

3 (c) A statement that the names and locations provided are  
4 provided for information only and are subject to change.

5 (2) The searchable database must allow users to search by zip  
6 code and include a map function displaying the closest locations to  
7 the user based on zip code.

8 (3) The department shall update the database quarterly.

9 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 18.64  
10 RCW to read as follows:

11 Beginning April 1, 2019, any pharmacy in the state with one or  
12 more pharmacists on staff that prescribe vaccines or self-  
13 administered hormonal contraceptives through a collaborative drug  
14 therapy agreement shall electronically provide the department with  
15 the information required by section 1 of this act, as requested by  
16 the department and in a format identified by the department.

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
