1 AN ACT Relating to increasing the mandatory retirement age for
2 Washington state patrol officers; amending RCW 43.43.250; and
3 providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.43.250 and 2007 c 87 s 1 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 ~~(1)((a) Until July 1, 2007, any member who has attained the age~~
8 ~~of sixty years shall be retired on the first day of the calendar~~
9 ~~month next succeeding that in which the member has attained the age~~
10 ~~of sixty. However, the requirement to retire at age sixty does not~~
11 ~~apply to a member serving as chief of the Washington state patrol.~~

12 ~~(b) Beginning July 1, 2007,)~~ Any active member who has obtained
13 the age of ~~((sixty-five))~~ sixty-eight years shall be retired on the
14 first day of the calendar month next succeeding that in which the
15 member has attained the age of ~~((sixty-five))~~ sixty-eight. However,
16 the requirement to retire at age ~~((sixty-five))~~ sixty-eight does not
17 apply to a member serving as chief of the Washington state patrol.

18 (2) Any member who has completed twenty-five years of credited
19 service or has attained the age of fifty-five may apply to retire as
20 provided in RCW 43.43.260, by completing and submitting an

1 application form to the department, setting forth at what time the
2 member desires to be retired.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect July 1, 2018.
