HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 4407

1            BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of the State of  
2 Washington, the Senate concurring, That immediately before  
3 adjournment SINE DIE of this 2017 2nd Special Session of the Sixty-  
4 fifth Legislature:

5            (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives  
6 all House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent  
7 resolutions, and House joint memorials in its possession that have  
8 not been passed by the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of  
9 Representatives of such measures they shall be assigned to the House  
10 Rules Committee for third reading; and

11            (2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate  
12 all Senate bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent  
13 resolutions, and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have  
14 not been passed by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by  
15 the Senate of such measures they shall be assigned to the Senate  
16 Rules Committee for third reading; and

17            BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the  
18 Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall retain in their  
19 possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE  
20 DIE of the 2017 2nd Special Session of the Sixty-fifth Legislature,  
21 all legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions,  
22 concurrent resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be

1 in their respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and  
2 other documents pertaining thereto; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any 3rd  
4 Special Session of the Sixty-fifth Legislature shall be numbered as a  
5 continuation of the numbers assigned to measures of the 2017 2nd  
6 Special Session of the Sixty-fifth Legislature.
