BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of the State of Washington, the Senate concurring, That immediately before adjournment SINE DIE of this 2017 3rd Special Session of the Sixtyfifth Legislature:

5 (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all bills, House joint resolutions, б House House concurrent resolutions, and House joint memorials in its possession that have 7 8 not been passed by the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of such measures they shall be assigned to the House 9 Rules Committee for third reading; and 10

(2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate 11 12 all Senate bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent 13 resolutions, and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by 14 the Senate of such measures they shall be assigned to the Senate 15 Rules Committee for third reading; and 16

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall retain in their possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE of the 2017 3rd Special Session of the Sixty-fifth Legislature, all legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be 1 in their respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and 2 other documents pertaining thereto; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any 4th 4 Special Session of the Sixty-fifth Legislature shall be numbered as a 5 continuation of the numbers assigned to measures of the 2017 3rd 6 Special Session of the Sixty-fifth Legislature.
