- 8 controlled substance if the person knowingly or intentionally permits 9 a dependent child or dependent adult to be exposed to, ingest,
- 10 inhale, or have contact with ((methamphetamine or)) a Schedule I or
- 11 Cabadula II controlled substance under about a 60 50 DOW including
- Schedule II controlled substance under chapter 69.50 RCW including ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or anhydrous ammonia, including their
- 13 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers, that are being used in the
- 14 manufacture of methamphetamine, including its salts, isomers, and
- 15 salts of isomers. Endangerment with a controlled substance does not
- 16 include exposure, ingestion, inhalation, or contact with a controlled
- 17 substance as administered pursuant to a prescription for a dependent
- child or dependent adult as outlined in chapter 69.50 RCW.
- 19 (2) Endangerment with a controlled substance is a class B felony.
