- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The Washington state economic growth commission is established to:
- 7 (a) Develop a state economic growth strategy related to 8 accelerating technology innovation; and
- 9 (b) Establish the feasibility and devise a plan for establishing 10 a manufacturing innovation institute.
 - The Washington state economic growth commission shall consist of sixteen voting members appointed by the governor as follows: One representative from the department of commerce, four representatives from academia, three representatives from private industry or trade associations, three representatives from a labor organization, one senior economist with expertise in manufacturing one representative from technology, Impact Washington, representatives from the workforce training and education coordinating board, and one representative from the state board for

- 1 (b) The chair of the commission is a voting member selected by 2 the governor with the consent of the senate, and serves at the 3 pleasure of the governor.
 - (3) The commission may adopt rules for its own governance and hire staff as needed to perform functions under this chapter.

- 6 (4) The commission may establish committees as it desires, and 7 may invite people who are not members of the commission to serve as 8 committee members.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Section 1 of this act constitutes a new 10 chapter in Title 43 RCW.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. The sum of three hundred fifty thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the general fund to the department of commerce for the purposes of this act. The department of commerce will contract with the state's manufacturing extension partnership.
