- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 74.09.340 and 2017 c 270 s 2 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 ((Effective July 1, 2017)) (1) Except as provided in RCW
- 8 72.36.160, beginning January 1, 2019, the personal needs allowance
- 9 <u>for clients being served in medical institutions and in residential</u>
- 10 <u>settings</u> is <u>seventy dollars</u>.
- 11 (2) Beginning January 1, 2020, and each ((fiscal)) year
- 12 thereafter, subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for
- 13 this specific purpose, the personal needs allowance shall be adjusted
- 14 for economic trends and conditions by increasing the allowance by the
- 15 percentage cost-of-living adjustment for old-age, survivors, and
- 16 disability social security benefits as published by the federal
- 17 social security administration. However, in no case shall the
- 18 personal needs allowance exceed the maximum personal needs allowance
- 19 permissible under the federal social security act.
